

Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 25.01.2010  
at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur

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The District Collector, Anantapur at the beginning of the meeting requested all the District / concerned officers to give suggestion for additions or deletions on the base line survey schedules designed for preparation of Action Plan to develop the Govindapuram and Gangulavaripalyma villages of Madakasira Mandal.

H'ble MLA Madakasira briefly explained the importance attached to preparation of right Action plan for this work and hence requested all the officers to involve in this work, as the H'ble Minister of Agriculture is very interested in overall development of those two villages. The District collector thanked the MLA, Madakasira for his interaction on the issue.

The District Collector briefly reviewed the arrangements being done for Republic day celebrations at Parade Ground and instructed to keep the stalls arranged by the Departments to be exhibited up to 6.00 PM and one departmental person may be made available to explain the details to the visitors like students, public etc .

It is decided in the meeting to visit villages in surprise by all the District officers on first Wednesdays starting from 10.2.2010 . For this visits all officers will travel in a bus. This would be convergence in bus.

A review has been taken up by the District Collector with each and every District Officer on the list of awardees for republic day proposed by them, with detailed remarks on the extraordinary performance of the employee and instructed to short list their proposals.

The following instructions were issued by the District collector during the meeting :

1. Amount of Rs 11.00 lakhs received under infra to Housing department to utilize at the earliest. **Action :: PO Housing.**

2. To redress the drinking water problem at Kadiri Municipality as water is being supplied once in 5 days in the Municipality.

**Action :: SE , PH**

3. To prepare estimates for the Road leading to FCI GODOWNS at Kandukuru village, to lay new Road under BRGF and also for maintenance of the existing Road.

**Action :: SE PR**

4. To install sufficient number of sign boards in NH 7 as there are many deep cut points at Penukonda, Chilamathur and even up to Bangalore. As it is said that the Road work is completed there are a few diversion boards, there is every possibility for accidents and it is becoming very difficult to drive during nights .

**Action :: PD National High Ways.**

5. Regarding Demolishing of Community Toilets in villages, the DPO to issue two line paper advertisement inviting private contractors for construction as well as maintenance of flush toilets in the villages . It is also instructed that steps may be initiated to take up under BRGF to construct the flush toilets where existing toilets are proposed for demolition, and the Gram Panchayats may be assigned with maintenance aspect of the proposals. All the C-concerned Officers to complete the entire work with in 4 weeks and weekly progress has to explain in convergence meetings.

**Action : DPO, SE PR, SE RWS, DTWO, & CEO ZP.**

6. To ensure 100% presence of Mandal level officers for the Friday Convergence meetings at all Mandal Headquarters. Particularly the Bank Mangers who are at rarely attending the meetings.

**Action :: LDM**

7. To stop addressing Tahasildars for exemption to INTEGRATED SUEVEY, as it is Govt. work and all departments have to do it. No exemption will be given to any employee, and action will also be initiated against the absentees.

**Action :: All Officers.**

8. To see that closing balances in Mid day meals to be furnished by the respective MEOs every month by 6<sup>th</sup> . DEO to follow up

**Action :: DEO.**

9. To co-ordinate the Mass Education programme - Essay writing competitions in the district, with the involvement of all District

Officers. Every month topic to be published well in advance. The NYK Coordinator will be the Convener for this programme.

**Action:: NYK co-coordinator and all officers.**

10. To give power point presentation and high light discussion on Sakshara Bhaarathi by Rajiv Vidya Mission in the next week convergence meeting. **Action :: PO RVM & DEO**

**After which other convergence issues were taken up.**

- The P.D National Highways requested for alienation of 11.00 Acres of land for Road works at Peddavadugur and Gooty. **Action: RDO, Anantapur.**
- The EE Social Welfare requested for alienation and advance position of land to construct Social Welfare Residential School at Kanekal. **Action: RDO, Dharmavaram.**
- The Chief Executive Officer, Zilla parishad requested for All Officers to give their departmental action plan for next one year ( with specific details) and action plans for next 5 years and 20 years ( may be flexible) without link to BRGF. The action Plan be sent by all departments . **Action: All concerned Officers.**
- The Special Officer, Gummagatta raised an issue that there is drinking water problem in Bhupasamudram and Gone Baavi villages and requested to fill critical gaps in the issue. **Action: SE RWS & SE TRANSCO.**
- The DEE TRANSCO Kadiri requested for payment of dues from Municipal Commissioner and Tahasildar, Kadiri. **Action:: Tahasildar & MPL. Commissioner, Kadiri**
- The SE TRANSCO requested for alienation of land to newly sanctioned TRANSCO Offices at Rappthadu, Brahmasamudram , Gandlapenta and Obulapuram Villages. The Dist. Collector instructed to submit proposals by next week ending to concerned Revenue Divl. Officers. **Action :: TRANSCO officials, PKD Sub-Collector & RDOs.**
- The PD DWMA , raised an previous issue of taking possession of 8 year old tamarind tress by Panchyats . It is requested to convene division wise meetings to Panchayat Secretaries and Sarpanchs on the issue. **Action : DPO**

- The PD DWMA, requested for alienation of land for constructing APD offices including Meeting halls at Dharmavaram, Rayadurg, Uravakonda, Anantapur, O.D. Cheruvu and Tadipathri. And also one DLRC building at Anantapur.

**Action :: RDOs**

- The PD DWMA, informed that under NREGP there is provision for Development and maintenance of irrigation tanks. Hence @ 10 tanks may be identified in each division and can be taken up for development.

**Action :: SE MI**

Before concluding the meeting the District Collector requested the PD DWMA to brief about the development in NREGP in the District. In this connection the Project director explained that the peak season started in the district. It is targeted to provide at least another 80 days of wage employment in the district without agitations from the Ryots. It is also requested to all the Special Officers to improve the quality of NREGS programme and to pursue with the MPDOs to see that 2.00 lakhs works be sanctioned . Normal SEVEN Working hours at work sites should invariably be followed. As per the latest G.O any requirements at work sites may be purchased. It is also informed that to avoid delay in payments, Central Fund Management system is also introduced and to be made use by all concerned. As Anantapur is very deserving District, entire funds released for the district are to be utilized with the involvement of MPDOs, Special Officers and Work force.

Finally the District Collector in the concluding remarks, instructed all the District Officers to work for the Grand success of the Republic Day celebrations.
