2) Mass Deworming Programme : Every year two times deworming will be taken up by department, 42.45 Lakhs of Sheep and Goat dewormed in the 1st phase for year 2010-11.

3) Foot And Mouth Disease Control Programme: Foot and Mouth Disease vaccination programme will be taken up twice in a year by the department at free of cost. In the month of May, 2010 8.91 lakhs cattle were vaccinated under this programme.

5) Fodder Development :- Supply of fodder seed at 75% subsidy to individual farmers.

This year 2010-2011, 25.00 M.Ts of Fodder Seed was distributed to 2950 farmers to raise fodder in 2706 acres.

6) ATMA Perennial Fodder Production :- During the year 2009-10 through Agricultural Technology Management Agency, Anantapur, support an amount Rs.6.30 lakhs has been released towards perennial fodder development. 625 perennial fodder plots (each 0.5 acres @ Rs.1000/- financial support). Raised in an area of 312.5 Acres. The plots serve as demonstration cum fodder slip distribution plots.

10) Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana :-

Induction of Milch Animals:- Under this programme by utilizing Rs.45.0 lakhs, 357 milch animals were distributed.

Supply of Breeding Rams :- Under this programme 651 Breeding rams were distributed by utilizing an amount of Rs.9.765 lakhs during the year 2009-10.

During this year 2010-11 till to day, 261 Breeding rams are distributed by utilizing an amount of Rs. 3.915 lakhs.
