Passengers Friendly Schemes:

01. MONTHLY SEASON TICKETS:

- Under this system, a commuter can pay fare for 20 days and travel on all days of the month upto 100 KMs on Ordinary and Express routes and it is valid for 30 days from the date of purchase.
- 2775 Monthly Season Tickets are sold upto 31.08.2010.

02. JHT (JUBILEE HITECH TICKET):

- Passenger can perform journey anywhere, any number of times within Andhra Pradesh State for 07 days in any Super Luxury or lower class of services and at the tariff of Rs.850/- (Adult) and Rs. 425/- (Child).
- 968 Jubilee Hitech Tickets are sold upto 31.08.2010.

03. IJHT (INTERSTATE JUBILEE HITECH TICKET):

- Passenger can perform journey any number of times, anywhere within and outside AP wherever the RTC buses are under operation for a period of 07 days in any Super Luxury or lower class of services and at the tariff of Rs.1300/- (Adult) and Rs. 650/- (Child).
- 31 IJHTs are sold upto 31.08.2010.

04. CAT CARDS:

“Concessional Annual Travel” (CAT) Card Scheme has the following features:

- The tariff of the fresh card is Rs.200/-, thereafter Rs.180/- for 1st renewal, Rs.160/- for 2nd renewal, Rs.140/- on 3rd and beyond renewals and is valid for one year from the date of issue in Super Luxury, Deluxe, Express, Pallevelugu services, to get a concession of 10% on fare in each journey.
- Insurance coverage ranges from Rs.1.50 lakhs to 2.0 lakhs in case of death of the card holder due to accident while traveling in APSRTC bus paid apart from the statutory compensation.
- 18355 Cat Cards are sold upto 31.08.2010.

05. COUPLE GIFT CARDS:

- This ticket facilitates the Couple to travel anywhere in the Andhra Pradesh State for 04 days in any Super Luxury or lower class of services at the tariff of Rs.1200/-.
- 523 Couple Gift Cards are sold upto 31.08.2010.

06. FREE TRAVEL FOR PASSENGERS BOARDING/ALIGHTING AT PERIPHERAL POINTS:

Free travel facility can be availed of all types of City buses and district buses going to peripheral colonies after reaching MGBS for the passengers who alight from long distance (250 KMs, and above) direct services on the strength of Tickets/TIM issued ticket (with in 2 hours) in Hyderabad and Secunderabad, Vijayawada and Vishakapatnam cities.

07. COMPUTERISED RESERVATION FACILITY:

Online Passenger Reservation System (Any Where to Any Where) is provided at Anantapur, Hindupur, Kadiri, Puttaparthi, Dharmavaram, Tadipathri, Gooty, Guntakal and Bangalore. 80 ATB Agents are available in the region including Bangalore Point.

08. CONCESSIONAL / FREE TRAVEL:

APSRTC endeavors to provide free travel / concession in fare as per the policy of the Govt. and financial viability. The types of Free / Concessional bus passes issued to different category of commuters in the society, and the extent of concession allowed category-wise is as follow.

09. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL:

- Complaint / Suggestion Book will be made available with Conductor of Mofussil services and at all important Bus Stations as classified.
- The complaints / Suggestion will be immediately acknowledged and action taken reported ordinarily in 15 days and before 30 days in case where detailed enquiries are required.
- 41 Representations cleared through Prajapatham.
- 28 Representations are cleared through Grievance meetings.

10. CIVIL ENGINEERING WORKS:

- Safe Drinking water facility has been provided at Anantapur, Tadipatri, Kadiri and Puttaparthi Bus Stations with approximate cost of Rs. 1.50 lakhs.
- Gooty Bus Station renovation works were taken up with Rs. 2.50 lakhs.
- An amount of Rs.One lakh has been spent for renovation of Penukonda Bus Station.
- An amount of Rs.One lakh has been spent for renovation of Lepakshi Bus Station and it is put into usage.
- CC works at Dharmavaram Bus Station worth of Rs.8.50 lakhs is under progress.
- CC works at Dharmavaram Bus Depot worth of Rs.14.50 lakhs is under progress.
- Proposals were sent for sanction of Rs. 05.00 lakhs for CC at Kadiri Bus Station.
- Proposals were sent for sanction of Rs.24.00 lakhs for procurement of “ROS” plant with view to provide Safe Drinking water to the employees in all the Depots.

11. SPECIAL OPERATIONS:

- 193 Special Buses are operated to Penukonda during the 500th Coronary Celebrations of Sri Krishandevarayana of Vijayanagara Empire.
- 196 Hanuman Darshan Special Buses were operated in Sravanamasam 2010 covering Muradi, Nemkal and Kasapuram Hanuman Temples.
- 800 Special buses are planned for operation in view of Bhagavan Sri Satya Sai Baba birth day celebrations during November 2010.
- 100 Special buses are planned for operation for the ensuing Navarathri Bramhostvams of Lord Sri Venkateswara Swamy at Tirupathi.
