Establishment: The District B.C. Service Coop. Society Ltd., Anantapur is established in the year 1976 and started its functioning from 1977.

Schemes Objectives:- and norms B.C. Corporation is extending loans to the all B.C. Community people by extending subsidy from corporation to Rural beneficiaries @ R.10,000/- and Urban beneficiaries @ 20,000/- each applicant identified by MPDOs/Municipal Commissioners through Grama/ Ward Sabhas for the eligible persons with Bank linkage besides Beneficiary Contribution with the following schemes/Petty Shops, Weaving Units, Sheep Units, Milch Animals, Tailoring, Barber Shops, Laundry etc.,

1) Margin Money Scheme:- For Rural Backward Classes people

2) Rajiv Abhyudaya Yojana Scheme:-For Urban Backward Classes people

3) Washermen, Nayee Brahmin & Vaddera Federation :- For the welfare of Rajakas, Nayee Brahmins and Vadderars Community societies.

With the following reservation norms 33 ¾ B.C Women, 3% Disabled Persons among the selected beneficiaries

- The unit cost shall be around Rs.40,000/-. Over & above unit cost, the Bank has to release the amount under Rajiv Abhyudaya Yojana scheme.
- Average subsidy per individual works out to Rs.20,000/- to cover Physical Target under Rajiv Abhyudaya Yojana scheme.
- The benefit of Pavala Vaddi scheme as applicable to Women Self Help Groups shall be extended to the beneficiaries of the B.C. Corporation.

II. Washermen, Nayee Brahmin & Vaddera Federation 2010-11


