Priority developmental works

1) Fodder Development

- a) **Reddipalli Farm:-** It is proposed to develop perennial fodder in 10 A/c land at Fodder Seed Multiplication Farm, Reddipalli.

Amount required: Rs.7.50 lakhs

It is proposed to supply fodder slips for the beneficiaries to whom perennial fodder units sanctioned under MG-NREGS programme in Anantapur and Uravakonda divisions.

- b) **Govt. Sheep Farm, Penukonda:-** It is proposed to develop perennial fodder in 3 A/c land at Govt. Sheep Farm, Penukonda .

Amount required: Rs.2.25 lakhs

It is proposed to supply fodder slips for the beneficiaries to whom perennial fodder units sanctioned under MG-NREGS programme in Hindupur, Penukonda divisions.

- 2) **Provision of Vehicle:-** Presently there is only one vehicle available at Joint Director (AH), Anantapur , and the same is utilized by the Joint Director (AH) for monitoring of various Animal Husbandry Department Activities.

16200 beneficiaries / units have been identified under MG-NREGS programme in the district covered in 5 divisions. For monitoring of speedy implementation of the programme one vehicle may be sanctioned / provided to the district.

Since no budget allocations have been provided towards propulsion charges an amount of Rs.2.00 lakhs may be provided from any of the funds available under the disposal of the District Collector, Anantapur towards propulsion charges, since monitoring of Pasukranthi and other developmental activities is essential.

- 3) **At Government level:-** Proposals were submitted to the Government for allocation of 5 Acres of land for construction of Sheep and Goat market yard in the district. Funds are available for construction of sheep market yard and the same is pending due to non availability of land.

5 Acres of land may be provided from any of the Government lands available in and around Anantapur.

- 4) **Provisions of Tables & Chairs:-** All 63 mandals are supplied with computers under National Disease control and monitoring programme. But no tables and chairs are supplied. An amount of Rs.2.52 lakhs is required for purchase of Tables and chairs to ensure proper use of computers. The same may be provided from any of the funds available with the District Collector, Anantapur.
