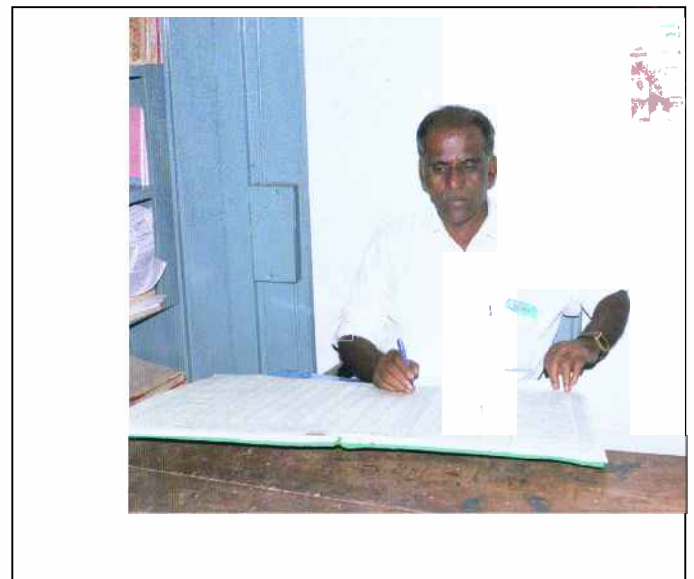


6. Grma sabas:
