

BRIEF NOTE ON ACTIVITIES OF COOPERATION DEPARTMENT

Anantapur District comprises of 3 Divisions having totally 63 Mandals. Anantapur, Dharmavaram and Hindupur are the Headquarters of 3 Divisional Cooperative Officers. The Office of the District Cooperative Officer is placed in Anantapur Town. Since starting of the Cooperative Movement, Anantapur District has stood pioneer in implementation of Cooperative Schemes for the welfare of the Poor People. Particularly, the Cooperative Movement in Anantapur District is known for its vital role in serving the farmers by way of providing crop loans through DCCBs besides it plays vibrant role in supply of fertilizers and pesticides and Agriculture Credit under Short Term, Long Term loaning and as well as Non-form Sector Development from time to time to the needy farmers through various cooperative institutions like DCMS, Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies in the District.

I further submit that the District Cooperative Office, Anantapur stood 6th place in the State basing on the review conducted by the Commissioner for Cooperation and Registrar of Cooperative Societies on the progress and achievement on the following performance Indicators besides the District Cooperative Office, Anantapur stood 2nd place in the State in completion of Audit of 118 PACS.


❖ **Enquires:** I submit that 03 Enquiries under Section 51 of the APCS Act was ordered, out of which one Enquiry was completed leaving a balance of 02 Enquiries.

- ❖ **Inspections:** I submit that Four Inspection under Section 52 of the APCS Act was ordered and one inspection U/s 52 has been completed and I have strictly directed the concerned to complete 03 Inspections (Putlur PACS, Dharmavaram CHBS and Kadiri CHBS Ltd., Kadiri) reports in the stipulated time.
- ❖ **Surcharge Notices:** I submit that 05 surcharge notices were issued covering an amount of Rs.27.88 Lakhs out of which 01 case was disposed covering an amount of Rs.2.19 Lakhs and leaving a balance of Rs.25.69 Lakhs for 04 cases. Efforts are being made to dispose all the pending surcharge notices at the earliest.
- ❖ **Misappropriation cases:** I submit that out of 14 misappropriation cases one case was disposed leaving a balance of 13 cases covering an amount of Rs.55.64 Lakhs. The disposal in this regard is not possible as all the cases were pending in various courts.
- ❖ **Issue of certificates U/s.71:** I submit that 516 certificates U/s.71 covering an amount of Rs.810.52 Lakhs were received, out of which 440 cases covering an amount of Rs.755.49 lakhs have been disposed off, leaving a balance of 76 cases covering an amount of Rs.55.03 Lakhs.
- ❖ **Arbitrations:** I submit that 22 Arbitration cases covering an amount of Rs.22.24 Lakhs were received and the same was disposed off
- ❖ **Execution Petitions:** I submit that out of 2772 EPs covering an amount of Rs.483.85 Lakhs, 117 E.Ps covering an amount of Rs.42.16 Lakhs were disposed off leaving the balance of 2655 E.Ps covering an amount of Rs. 441.690 Lakhs.
- ❖ **Liquidation cases:** I submit that out of 04 liquidation societies ordered and final closure in respect of 03 societies have been completed.
 - Further, I submit that 194 Weaker Section societies were ordered for liquidation out of which 91 societies have completed final closure, leaving a balance of 103 societies.
- ❖ **Fertilizer & Pesticide Business:** During the current year 45 PACS have made the business worth of Rs.4087.10 Lakhs under my supervision through DCMS and PACS.
- ❖ **Government Dues recoveries:** I submit that an amount of Rs.1.8 Lakhs was recovered during the month.
- ❖ **Periodical Inspections:** I submit that out of 539 Periodical Inspections, 292 periodical Inspections were completed leaving a balance of 247 Inspections.
- ❖ **Registration of Mutually Aided Cooperative Societies:** I submit that 118 Self Help Groups have been registered under AP MACS Act 1995 for the last 06 months and an amount of Rs.118000/- was collected through Challans and remitted it to the Government.
- ❖ **Audit of Aided Societies:** I submit that out of 447 Aided societies programmed for audit during the year 2009-2010, Audit of 400 Societies were completed leaving the balance of 47 and Audit Certificates were also issued.
- ❖ **Audit of Un-Aided Societies:** I submit that out of 311 Un-Aided societies programmed for Audit during 2009-2010, Audit of 280 Societies were completed leaving the balance of 31.
 - As per the instructions of the Additional Registrar /Chief Auditor O/o. the Commissioner for Cooperation and Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad I have convened a review meeting with all the auditors regarding to the implementation of Common Accounting System in all Primary Agricultural Societies and special audit teams are constituted for completion of Audit by end of September-2010.

Election to PACS-2010: The Commissioner for Cooperation and Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has proposed to hold the elections of all societies as per the Act and Rules and directed the District Cooperative Officers to make necessary arrangements for preparation of voter list of all PACS in the District.

On the behest of the instructions I have made all arrangements for conduct of Elections and voter lists have been prepared for all the 118 PACS. Recently the **Cabinet Sub-Committee have deferred the conduct of Elections and ordered to continue the same board for a period of 6 months or till conduct of Election which ever is earlier. Accordingly the orders has been communicate to all the 120 PACS in the District.**
