I submit that the District Collector, Anantapur has directed the District Officers to submit one page note on Progress and Achievement. of their departmental activities as on 31-05-2011.

In this context I submit that the Cooperative Sector plays a distinguished role in serving the farmers at grass root level by way of providing crop loans, L.T., S.T, Personals loans, Gold loans and O.D loans etc., and also plays vibrant role in supply of fertilizers pesticides and insecticides to the needy farmers through various cooperative institutions like DCCB, DCMS, Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies.

Moreover the five Cooperative Town Banks existing in the District are having 80% client base of middle class strata and the bank is providing L.T, S.T., jewel and house mortgage loans to the needy, venerable and downtrodden sections in the district who can not get loans from commercial banks. It provides loans with lesser rate of interest when compare to other commercial banks and these banks running on sound lines and also inculcate the habit thrift / savings among the members and mobilize various kind of deposits from the members.

The 15 PACS have supplied has supplied 110587.00 quintal ground nut and other Seeds to the needy farmers for the year 2010-2011 in coordination and with the assistance of ADCC Bank Ltd., Anantapur.

The District Marketing Cooperative Society has also done business turnover of Rs. 5112.21 Lakhs by supply of Fertilizers and pesticides through 45 PACS to the needy farmers.

Moreover the District Cooperative officer have registered 3434 number of societies under AP MACS Act 1995 in the District, of them 2710 societies which are registered are of Self Help Groups of IKP and MEPMA . The societies are inculcating the habit of thrift among the members and issuing loans to the members on revolving basis so that the members are now self reliant, doing domestic business and eking out their livelihood with the functioning of these societies. The Government is also getting 1% registration fee on share capital as well as annual return fees of Rs.50/- per annum from the above registered societies. So far an amount Rs.4.50 Lakhs has been received so far as Annual fees from these societies during the current fiscal.
