

## Note on Achievement of Revenue Department in Penukonda division

The following achievements were made in Penukonda division, Anantapur District up to 30.9.2010.

1. Assignment of land : An extent of 2649.64 Ac of land distributed to 1274 beneficiaries during the 5<sup>th</sup> phase land distribution in Penukonda division.
2. Alienation of land: An extent of 434-24 Ac was proposed for alienation in f/o APIIC for establishment of Industrial Park under SEZ.
3. Land Acquisition : Award passed to an extent of 9-71 Ac and P.V submitted to an extent of 40-60 Ac and D.N and D.D submitted for 125.11 Ac. Award passed to an extent of 9-71 Ac.
4. Collections: An amount of Rs 3,62,117/- has been collected towards Water Tax. An amount of 15,1,054/- has been collected as NALA in the division. Rs. 19,51,023/- was collected as one time land conversion fee in the division.
5. Unique numbers have been assigned in 394 villages in the division covering 230097 pass books with 79 %. 136 Bogus Pattadar pass books detected during the process. It is noticed that in 173 cases, an extent of 307.73 Ac was manipulated.
6. During the Marpula Masam 9715 changes have been incorporated in the village accounts.
7. 21452 farmers in the division were facilitated in obtaining crop loan from Banks by supplying computerized adangal extract to them by collecting an amount of Rs. 3,21,784 towards cost.
8. During the Special Summary revision notices were served to 70354 voters for supply of photos and 33755 photos were collected.
9. Proposals submitted for sanction of APATBANDU in 62 cases and relief in 7 suicidal death cases
10. During the integrated survey 28,247 cards deleted as bogus and 1,78,707 units saved.
11. Conducted 500<sup>th</sup> year coronation celebrations of Sri Krishna Deva Raya in Penukonda as a state function. His excellence Governor of Andhra Pradesh, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh and Central Government and State Government Ministers also attended the function. Nearly 5,00,000 people from various parts of the District have visited and enjoyed the cultural and other programmes. The concluding functions will remembered as land mark in the History of Penukonda.
12. Protocol: Observed protocol to VIP's such as Chief Minister of A.P., Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Ministers for Government of India, Ministers for Andhra Pradesh State and Hon'ble Judges from various High Courts and Supreme Court.
13. Hon'ble Sri Krishna Committee visited the division during the month of August 2010 and expressed satisfaction after interaction with the people.
