

Minutes of the Convergence meeting held in the DWMA hall on 06-06-2011

Initiating the meeting the Dist Joint Collector has asked the Lead District manager to enlighten on the guidelines communicated in rescheduling the loans given during 2009-10 as the district is affected by natural calamities. On this the Lead District manager informed that the guidelines are communicated to all bank branches and rescheduling is in the process a cushion to farmers and installments are to be paid in next four years from 2012 onwards. Also informed that lending of fresh loans is taken up as June 30th being the last day for taking loan in the New Weather Based Crop Insurance scheme to be implemented from 2011-12 in the district. He has cleared the apprehensions of certain officers on coverage of insurance to rescheduled loanees and to clear instalments along with next year repayments to get future benefits. The Joint Collector instructed to put up the village- wise schedule on the notice boards in all bank branches .

(Action: Lead District Manager)

The Revenue Divisional Officer, Penukonda has requested that the tank with 25 ac ayacut in Cherlopalli village of Penukonda mandal be renewed by taking up desilting under MGNREGS. The Project Director, DWMA has agreed to take up the work. In this Connection ,The Joint Collector has instructed all the Revenue Divisional Officers to take up land improvement programmes in the fifth phase Assignment of land .

(Action: Project Director, DWMA and all Revenue Divisional Officers)

The Joint Collector has enquired into the payments of Janani suraksha Yojana pending bills .On this the District Medical and Health Officer has submitted that the pending bills are cleared from the available funds as directed by the Collector in the previous Convergence meeting .

The Joint Collector has instructed Asst Director, Handlooms and Textiles to complete issue of cards with the cooperation of Project Directors, MEPMA and DRDA and to complete payments of incentives to weavers in Dharmavaram and other parts of the Dist.

(Action: Asst Director, H&T, Project Directors, MEPMA and IKP)

The Project Director DWMA has requested all the District Officers to provide list of lands available in their jurisdiction for raising nurseries demonstration plots. He also requested to take plantation in APSEB substations in the dist where adequate vacant sites are available. On this Supdt. Engineer TRANSCO informed that no such vacant sites are available in their sub stations.

(Action: Project director, DWMA, All Special Officers)

The District Informatics Officer has reported that only few departments have given data on updation of District Web site. The Joint Collector has instructed that all the remaining District officers to send the updation reports by next meeting.

(Action: District Informatics Officer and District Officers)

Revenue Divisional Officer , Anantapur has requested Supdt Engineer TRANSCO to provide power supply to the Tabjula –I and Tabjula –II Indiramma colonies On this He replied that it is not possible for them to drill the rocky soil for erection of lines He has been instructed to seek permission for blasting..On frequent power cuts in Penukonda , he informed that wind is a major obstruction for Transmission and informed that 132 KV station is sanctioned to the area and the problem would be sorted out.

(Action: Supdt Engineer TRANSCO)

District Revenue Officer has reviewed the position of redressal of grievances by concerned departments and requested all the District Officers to clear pending references in the web site. He also reviewed Collector camp office references and instructed to immediately clear by submitting a copy to the Collector's camp office .

(Action : All District Officers)

Joint Director , Agriculture has explained the over all position on the availability of Ground seed in all mandals for second phase seed distribution second phase. In N.P. Kunta ,Kadiri, Kothacheruvu, Penukonda ,Puttaparthi Lepakshi and Vajrakarur where adequate supplies are to be replenished with K6 varieties as huge demand is cropped up in later stages. On Seed treatment supply he explained that 85000 pockets are available and additional 50000 pockets are to be received by today and without any trouble first day farmers will be given packets in their villages through the agencies in two days.He is instructed to meet the District Collector by 8.30 pm with clear position. He is instructed to give SMS every day to Collector and Joint Collector on seed availability.

He is instructed to see that boards are displayed in all counters and godowns in case of non availability of seed. Spl. Officers are instructed to be available and monitor keep going round in the distribution counters and to give report on Stock position and short falls noticed.

(Action : Joint Director, Agriculture, Spl Officers)

Project Director, Housing is instructed not to take 9115 applications that were later received into account as per Rachabanda Programme . On this he informed that the Commissioner Housing has given instructions to consider Category –III cases also. Joint Collector instructed to reconcile the figures with Chief Planning Officer.On road laying to Indiramma colony located on hillock in Kummara Nagepalli and Silparamam in Puttaparthi mandal he is instructed to take up identification of bore well

points and feasibility of water on the hillock and visit by the team of Geologist, Supdt Engineers, Panchayat Raj and RWS

On Kamarupalli of Anantapur mandal the Joint inspection with Supdt Engineer is completed & work is under progress.

Project Officer, Sarva Siksha Abhayan has requested all special officers to discuss in Weekly mandal Convergence meeting Education Week to be taken up from 13th to 19th – Vidyavaarothsavaalu and from 20th to 25th to follow up programme and requested all the special officers to aware that the mandal, day wise schedule of the programme to make it grand success.
