

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 16.5.2011

Instructions issued

1. SE TRANSCO is instructed to give the latest position of transformers at the earliest.
2. The District Collector reviewed the arrangements for conduct of Rythu Chaitanya Yaatralu and requested all officers to conduct the programme successfully.
3. Review on NREGS programme was taken up in the meeting. After feed back from all super special officers it has been instructed to see that labour under NREGS programme of this year also to reach the last year record of 1.5 lakh . For this it has been instructed the DWMA Officials and CEO ZP to instruct the APOs and MPDOs to take keen interest to see that new guidelines sink up to lower level. It is also instructed to give written guidelines of GOI's listed admissible works copies to all special officers and Super special officers for early clarifications raised at field level and also to reiterate basic guidelines of NREGS to all the concerned. It is also opined that the Special Officers also need to be activated by motivational measures for good performance in NREGS.
4. Review on Drinking water situation in the district was taken up and instructed To see that no sacristy is faced in any area and also to immediately raise to the situation at Penukonda keeping in view of pilgrims needs in urusu. It is also instructed to replace transformer at Uravakonda. The PD Housing to issue instructions to the concerned to solve the drinking water problem in Yadiki mandal and also to see that CPW Scheme of in C.V. Palli village to function.
5. Regarding Kalyanamasthu programme it is instructed to take personal interest and Special Officers to push the message to the nook and corner villages to cover more couples .
6. Regarding Prajaavani grievance cell attendance of District Officers it has been reiterated that deputing of next staff will dilute the motto of the programme and hence instructed to take seriously the public grievance cell work including registration, updation and redressal of the petitions.
7. Regarding Seed Distribution programme it has been instructed to give notification copies to all the concerned including special officers.
8. Review on last week issues , CCO pending notes, Rachabanda petitions was also taken up instructed to take actions immediately.

Other issues Discussed in the meeting::

- The Tahasildar Anantapur requested the DRDA, DWMA, JD Agrl. DBCWO, DTWO and APMIP to release amounts as fixed by the Dist. Collector towards the expenses incurred by revenue department to celebrate A.P. formation day and Republic day celebrations .
- The P O RVM requested for early issue of advance position of land proposed for construction of KGBVs in Roll, C.K Palli and Bukkapatnam mandals. Action :: RDOs
- The J.D Animal Husbandry raised an issue that payments were not yet started for the completed fodder slips in the district due to which new slips are not yet commenced by the farmers. Hence requested for early payment. In this connection it has been informed that farmers are being paid through bank accounts only . The Dist. Collector instructed to issue clear guidelines to APOs settle the issue. Action :: PD DWMA and JD AH
- The Special Officers Putlur / DTWO raised an issue that in Kondapuram and Surepalli villages there are delayed payments in NREGS and requested for early payment. Action :: PDDWMA
- The Special Officer, Kalyanadurg / EE SW requested for give special permission to take up jungle clearance work in ZPH girls school in Kalyanadurg keeping in view of anticipated hazards . Action :: PD DWMA
- The Special Officer, Tadimarri / AD Horticulture II requested for technical support from Animal Husbandry Department for raising fodder slips in the mandal. In this regard it has been instructed to develop more convergence between the DWMA and A.H. Action:: JD AH. & PD DWMA.
- The RDO Penukonda requested for replacement of transformer for drinking water purpose at yerravankapalli of Nallamada mandal .
- The RDO DMM requested for maintenance of URDU school building at Lonukota of Dharmavaram municipality, and also sanction of housing colony at Kanekal. . Action EE SW & PD Housing.
- The PD IKP Urban / MEPMA appreciated the work done by all the concerned officer in organizing the medical camp cum selection of surgery cases of polio in BIRDS, Tirupathi on 14th and 15th of this month.

- The Addl. Joint Collector requested all officers to finalise the list of voluntary persons identified to teach in schools and hostels in the district under Vidyaku Cheyutha programme by the next week. Further it is also instructed to come for meeting at 5.00 Pm next day with the MEOs of municipalities to finalise the rationalization process of teachers. Action:: DEO RDOs
- The District Collector instructed to identify site for construction of polytechnic by Acharya N.G Ranga university at Reddipalli. Action :: RDO ATP, JD AGrl and ANGRUniversity
- The DD Social Welfare raised an issue that hotel building are being asked for storage of G.Nut seed. It is the past experience that a lot of damage was done to the buildings during the last year. Hence requested suggest alternative to this. Hence it is decided to deposit Rs 5000/- as caution deposit by the agrl. Department to the HWO / ASWO. Further it is also instructed to clear off all stocks before opening of schools. Action :: JD agrl.
- The EE SW raised an issue that in Kanekal one KGBV school construction work is being obstructed by Sri Mohd Musthafa and raising complications to complete the work. As the contractor approached the station house officer to file complaint rejected to register. Hence requested to settle the issue. Action :: RDO DMM.
- The P.D Housing requested for early furnishing of estimate for Hindupur housing colony electrification work. In this connection the Addl. Joint Collector instructed the Pd Housing to give entire pending list of infrastructure proposals pending with the line departments for early action. Action SE TANSCO and all others .
