

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 20.6.2011

At the outset the District Collector asked for feedback from Special Officers on conduct of the Social Audit on issue of G.Nut seed in all villages and instructed

- To ensure receipt of feedback reports from all special officers by next week-
- To take action on the concerned against the complaints received in Chinaganapalli village of Amadagur mandal as informed by the Special Officer.
- To continue the social audit in left over villages in the ensuing Friday.

The District Collector informed about the implementation relating to licensed farmers identification and issue of Id cards to them in the District. In this connection the following were informed and requested the Special Officers to go through the G.O and take the concepts to the public and to enquire about this in the Friday meetings.

1. that the rights assured to the licensed farmers are restricted only to the crop raised , but not on the land. All Land rights will be vested with the owner only. There is no threat of losing land rights by the owners.
2. Application Forms are available with the VROs and Village Organisations and can be made use of them.
3. Applications to be collected from 21st to 25th of this month and verification process through Gram sabhas will start from 26th onwards by the Revenue department teams
4. To instruct the Village Organizations of IKP to be available in villages to participate in this team action.

Review on the issues discussed during the previous meeting was taken up and instructed to sort out at the earliest.

The District Collector reviewed the Text books distribution status, Vidya Pakshotsavaalu, progress of Land development programme, and Housing department Rachabanda petitions clearing status during the meeting.

Other issues Discussed in the meeting ::

- The PO RVM requested to clear off the G.Nut stocks placed in the schools and also to bear the repair charges for the damages caused for storing of G.nut. In this connection it is instructed to furnish the entire list of school wise and Hostel wise damages caused by the seed agencies to the JD Agrl. **Action :: PO RVM & DDSW & JD Agrl.**
- The Chief Planning officer informed that instructions were issued by the Govt to identify one best mandal for implementation of 20 point programme. Accordingly formats were designed and communicated to all the concerned to furnish mandal wise targets and achievements of the department during the year 2010-11, and requested to furnish the information within a day to submit report to Government.

Action :: 20PP related officers

- The LDM informed that the rescheduling of loans were in progress and 325 cores of credit was given to farmers. The District Collector instructed to complete the entire target of re scheduling by june30th **Action :: LDM**
- The DIO informed that the subsidized G.nut seed received farmers lists are pending from Agali, Beluguppa. Brahmasamudram, Chilamthur, Dharmavaram, Kambadur, Kundurpi, Madakasira, Ramagiri, Rappthadu, Bukkaptnma and Settur mandals , to place in the website. **Action :: JD AGrI & Special Officers.**
- The Superintendent, Govt General Hospital raised an issue that some requests are being received to place the statue of Father Ferror in the premises of Hospital . Hence requested to permit to place the issue in the meeting of SGHC of the Hospital.
- The PD DWMA, raised an issue of furnishing the estimates and to issue demand notices (total 24 cases) to drill bore wells and giving of feasibility certificates (13 cases - even by availing the vehicle of DWMA by DD GWD) under RIDF programme at the earliest as it is along pending . **Action :: DD GWD & SE TRANSCO**
- The PD DWMA informed that during the last video conference held by the RD Commissioner ate, it has been instructed to get permission to drill bores with hand pumps to develop dry land horticulture, in view of overexploitation in the district. **ACTION :: DD GWD**
- The RDO Penukonda requested for sanction of trenching works to the burial grounds near Penukonda, and de silting work to the tank of cherlopalli udner NREGA. **Action PD DWMA**
- The DD Social welfare requested for allotment of rice to the welfare hostels as there are few stocks in the hostels in view of reopening of schools. **Action :: DSO**
- The DBCWO informed that College hostels for boys and girls separately were sanctioned in the district at each assembly constituency level for BC boys and can be popularized by all special officers and the willing candidates may aproac h the local HWO for applications. The District collector instructed to give press note to the extent . Further it is also requested to construct toilet block to the BC College girls hostel being run in the Children Home of Dharmavaram. **Action :: EE SW & PD Women &Child welfare.**
- The DD SW requested to takeup repairs in the Ambedkar Bhavan. For this the CEO ZP informed that some repairs were completed to the building, if any additional requirement to be informed in written to take action. **Action:: DDSW**
- The EE SW informed that H'ble ministers visits were scheduled in the district on 24th and 25th, and hence requested all officers to be attentive to the programmes. In this connection the district Collector instructed to adhere to the protocol by informing the programme to all the local public representative under proper acknowledgment to avoid complications.

- The PD DRDA informed that huge amounts are pending from all offices towards to EPF contribution amounts of the out sourcing employees from the Prasanthi Zilla Samakhya. Amount due from each department was informed and requested to clear off at the earliest as according to GOI instructions the ZS are need to be closed.
- The PD IKP (U)/ MEPMA requested for early payment of death claims from IKP rural . For this the PD DRDA requested to furnish the list to the office to release the amounts .
Action PD IKP URBAN & RURAL.
- The PD Housing informed that the petitions of Rachabanda programme of Chilamathur, Gorantla,Hindupur, Lepakshi, Parigi, Hindupur urban, Madakasiraa, Amarapuram, Gudibanda, Rolla, Agali and N.P.Kunta (partial) mandals are yet to be received and requested to send them immediately. Further it is also requested for joint inspection of Housing and Revenue staff to inspect the R C Buildings.
- The PD DWMA informed that all fresh fodder slips payments to be cleared immediately after planting. Any delayed payments to be brought to the notice of the PDDWMA.
- The District Revenue Officer reviewed the department, category wise pending Prajaavani Grievances cell petitions and requested to redress the status online, as totally there are 109 A category and 89 B category petitions are pending as on today . Further it is also informed the significance of this system i.e. developed to increase the accountability in government machinery and hence requested not to deviate from the original motto and also requested to intimate the action taken to the original petitioner with in time, to avoid re approach for the same grief.
- The EE Social welfare requested for release of payments due from DSO's office and expenses met for fixing the Sri Krishnadevaraya Statue in Penukonda.
- The District Collector instructed all the concerned officers to release amounts due to the Tahasildar , Anantapur being the expenses incurred for organizing the national festivals in Parade grounds.

The District Collector requested to all officers to furnish the department notes immediately to the DIO for updation in the official website of Anantapur District .
