

## Minutes of the Convergence meeting held on 07/03/2011

The District Collector initiated the review of 20 Point Economic Programme and instructed related District Officers to concentrate in achieving 100% achievement of targets. As the financial year is coming to nearing completion, instructed the Dist. Manager, Housing, Dist. Supply Officer and Project Director, ICDS to improve their performance so as to enable to secure better ranking this year. Further, the District Collector instructed the PD, Women & Child Welfare to include the functional anganwadis to improve the achievement.

**(Action: Dist. Manager, Housing, PD, Women & Child Welfare and Dist. Supply Officer, Anantapur)**

The District Collector reviewed the status of pending issues of previous meeting and instructed the following:

With regard to providing water source to the dhobighat at Vemulapadu village in Yadiki mandal, DD Groundwater requested the special officer for Yadiki mandal to ask MPDO to pay Rs1000/-fee for identification of Ground water source.

The District Collector reviewed the progress of Census work and the Revenue Divisional Officers reported that the enumeration work has been completed in all the mandals by 7<sup>th</sup> as per schedule.

While reviewing the Fee Reimbursement status, the District Officers of Welfare departments have reported that the entire amount has been released by the Government and adjusted to the concerned Educational Institutions.

The Special Officer, Kothacheruvu requested the District Collector for clearance from Dist. Panchayat Officer for demolition of community latrine at Talarlarla village.

**(Action: Dist. Panchayat Officer and SE, RWS)**

Regarding conduct of SSC examination in the district smoothly, the District Education Officer requested the Police, Transportation, Revenue, Postal and Labour to make the following necessary arrangements:

- To provide adequate bundobust at the examination centres
- To ensure closure of Xerox centres near the examination centres
- To depute 8 Tahsildars / Dy. Tahsildars as flying squads for smooth conduct of examinations
- To ensure timely dispatch of answer paper bundles on the same day.
- To provide additional bus services and to adjust timings to help students reach examination centre in time.
- The health department to provide para medical staff to attend to exigencies at the examination centres.

With regard to implementation of Mid Day Meal Scheme in the district , the District Collector requested the Project Director, DRDA to give a rejoinder to the press clippings regarding sanction of loans to the agencies as a part of gap funding.

The Special Officer, Garladinne requested the Dist. Manager, APS RTC for plying more trips between Mukundapuram and Garladinne villages.

**(Action: Dist.Manager, APS RTC)**

The Revenue Divisional Officer, Dharmavaram requested the Transport Authorities to check over loading of passengers in Autos.

**(Action: Dy.Transport Commissioner, Anantapur)**

The Dist.Medical and Health Officer, Anantapur requested the cooperation of District Officers to propogate on Sterilisations and help achieve targets.

**(Action: All Special Officers and District Officers)**

The Exe.Engineer, APEWIDC, Anantapur requested the Revenue Divisional Officer, Dharmvaram to provide additional 5 cents of land regarding construction of school building at Dharmavaram town.

**(Action: Revenue Divisional Officer, Dharmavaram)**

The Exe.Director, BC Corporation and Special Officer, Kothacheruvu requested the Superintendent , Post Offices, Anantapur to provide alternate insurance scheme in the place of closed Rs. 15/- scheme

#### **Other Issues raised**

- The District Revenue Officer requested to provide water tankers at MLC election centres located in Polytechnic College and to ensure uninterrupted power supply at proposed counting centres **(Action: SE,PH and SE, AP TRANSCO)**
- The Joint Director, Agriculture, Anantapur reported that the distribution of Input Subsidy to all the small and marginal farmers as per list is to be completed. **( Action: JD, Agriculture)**
- The Joint Director, Agriculture is instructed to give modalities of Pavalavaddi payments to all the bankers. **( Action: JD,Agriculture)**
- The Supdt.Engineer (RWS) and PO, SSA to inspect the hostels in Peddavadugur(Ramapuram) , Kudair(Marutla colony) **(Action: SE,RWS and PO,SSA)**
- The Special Officer, Kalyandurg requested for extension of pipeline to the housing colony in Golla village **( Action: SE,RWS)**

- The Asst. Director, Horticulture requested the Special Officers to ensure supply of vegetable seed kits in all the Welfare Hostels, Schools and Anganwadi centres in their jurisdiction. (Action: All Special Officers)
- The Superintendent Engineer, Public Health to commission all the water tanks as per the time frame specified. Also to attend leakages and voltage problems immediately (Action: SE, Public Health)
- The Supdt. Engineer, HLC to closely monitor the filling up of drinking water tanks for the ensuing summer (Action: SE, HLC)
- The Excise Superintendent to enquire into the liquor shop within 100 metres of temple at Amarapuram mandal and to ensure selling of liquor as per the marked price (Action: Excise Superintendent, Anantapur)
- The District Panchayat Officer to address all the Tahsildars for updation of panchayat electoral rolls to mark SC/ST/BC and Others against the names by 15<sup>th</sup> (Action: Dist. Panchayat Officer, Anantapur)
- The Dy. Director, Social Welfare requested the SE, RWS to rectify borewells in hostels located in Amarapuram, Rayadurg manals. (Action: SE, RWS)
- The Project Director, DWMA to depute staff for the MPDOs meeting regarding fodder development (Action: PD, DWMA)

The District Collector took up the Road Safety Meeting in the Convergence meeting. The Dy. Transport Commissioner briefed about the recent insurance policy covering the life risk of family including driver and requested all the District Officers to get insured under the same.

(Action: All Special officers)

The District Collector concluded the meeting with the following instructions to improve road safety:

- the Dy. Transport Commissioner and EE, National Highways to provide all sign boards with radiant stickers at Palasamudram Cross of Gorantla, Somandepalli and Penukonda T Junction.
- RTC not to stop at Palasamudram junction point to avoid accidents and a Bay may be created 100 metres away from the junction point.
- SE, PR, to provide speed breakers 50 metres away from the junction points
- EE, NH to provide a speed breaker at the entrance of Arts College, Anantapur
- Traffic Police to impose penalties on usage of cell phones while driving
