

Minutes of the Convergence meeting held on 20.12.2010

At the outset the Joint Collector informed about the organization of National Consumer's week celebrations to be organized upto 24th of this month and requested all concerned line departments officers to make arrangements for huge participation of all consumers for the closing session on 24.12.10

The District Collector reviewed the sand mining coordination committee meeting with the line departments of Mines & Geology, Ground water, RWS & Revenue and instructed :

- ❖ To get all certificates to be furnished by all departments to accord permission for transportation of sand.
- ❖ To levy fines and taxes with local body resolutions on illegal transportation of sand.
- ❖ To conduct auctions to get licenses for transportation sand.

The District Collector reviewed the inspections on Housing department conducted on Not started houses in 63 villages by all the Special Officers in 53 mandals . After interaction with the special officers, all reasons were categorised under 12 types and instructed as follows:

- ❖ The PD Housing to design uniform proforma and communicate to the Village Information Officers to get compliance report with them to know the number of houses not started with the category of reasons. This work will be completed in the next Friday mandal level convergence meeting, and consolidated report will be submitted to the District Collector.
- ❖ To cancel all ineligible, duplicate, non resident and not interested beneficiaries immediately from the sanction list to have original number to be grounded.
- ❖ To furnish the Action Taken report on the Special Officers Inspection reports pertaining to Housing in every Monday meeting for Dist Collectors review.
- ❖ The PD DRDA to take the responsibility of motivating the public for immediate starting of construction work. .

Other Instructions issued :

1. All the Officers to develop the skills of correspondence and building the files for best administration. Tools developed by previous systems of our predecessors to be continued by all the present officers.
2. The concepts behind insisting of Model House and Model toilet to be appraised to the people in the villages.

3. All Officers to give report every week in the meeting on any issues sorted out relating to their department either at state level or at lower level.
4. The SE TRANSCO to put efforts to extend the time limit to the special drive of providing Rs 125/- per meter up to 31.3.2011.
5. The DM NEDCAP to work in coordination with the Anantapur Municipal commissioner on all energy conservation programmes.

The District Collector reviewed in detail the quarterly analysis reports of all students' quarterly marks - class wise and subject wise, and noticed that there are huge numbers of failures in many subjects. In this connection all officers are requested to give suggestions, after thinking seriously, to improve the education standards in the district. In this connection it has been instructed

- The DD Social welfare to bring analysis reports of all hostel boarders marks, class wise and subject wise to the next Monday convergence meeting.
- The DEO to ensure in every month Head master's meeting that the analysis reports are being made for every examination and actions are initiated accordingly.
- To utilize the voluntary services of the retired teaching personnel available in the district for developing the education standards.

The District Collector reviewed the progress under Jawahar Bala Aarogya Beema programme with the DM & HO and instructed

- ✓ The DEO to issue circular to all schools directing the HMs to conduct health checkups to examine the eye sight of all the students to know the refractive error in vision with the assistance of the Science assistants and local medical personnel by the end of this academic year.
- ✓ The DM & HO to ensure the presence of the Medical Officers in afternoons also in the PHCs and to conduct medical checkups. It is decided that next month on wards every Thursday will be the medical examinations day and every Tuesday will be the referral day from next academic year, in all hospitals as per the guidelines of the insurance scheme.

Review on the Housing issues relating to line departments coordination was held and instructed to have good rapport among all officers for quick completion of all targeted houses in the District.

The District collector reviewed the progress under SGSY, S.C action plan assistance programmes with the LDM and instructed to complete all units grounding by December ending.

A review on Collector's Camp Office pending references was also taken up and instructed to call for explanation for huge pendency officers.

A review on the HLC / Minor irrigation sources water receipt position was also conducted and instructed to inform progress every week.

The District Collector reviewed the Red gram procurement measures adopted by the PD DRDA Agriculture, and other Departments involved in the latest MSP announced by the Govt. i.e. Rs 3500/- per Quintal. Which may lead the procurement price upto Rs. 5000/- Regarding this all Special Officers are instructed to raise up to the situation and see that all village level demand of redgram is met at village level itself. To provide credit to SHGs to procure redgram with a resolution at DLCC meeting scheduled to be convened on 28th of this month.

Review meeting with the Superintendents of Excise department on the inter department's issues was conducted and instructed to ensure that there are no belt shops in SC/ ST habitations. The Superintendents requested for cooperation from Revenue and Police Department in view of shortage of personnel in their department in tracing out & settling the cases.

Issues discussed :

- The Special Officer Bramhasamudram raised an issue that in Kurlakunta village, payments are due for the completed 56 model toilets taken up under Total sanitation programme. Hence requested for early payment as an action of motivation to others. . Action:: PD Housing, SE RWS & CEO ZP.
- The SE TRANSCO requested for alienation of land in HLC colony to construct Sub station. Action:: RDO Anantapur.
- The District collector reviewed the progress of NREGS works and instructed to see that the works to be commenced from January 2011 in all habitations immediately, in view of completion of all agri operations in the district. Action :: PD DWMA
- The Joint Collector informed about the AADHAR CARDS issuing programme to all citizens of India being implemented as pilot project in our district and in the selected mandals of Bathalapalli, Guntakal (R) and Penukonda. In this connection all special officers are requested to popularize the programme in public as the programme is having national importance and includes biometric methods involved.

- The District Collector instructed the Addl Joint Collector to continuously coordinate the imbalances being prevailed in the mid day meals closing balances and to initiate action on the concerned indenting officer / tahasildar.
- The PO RVM raised an issue that there are 40 street children were identified to join in schools and requested to provide residential accommodation to them. In this connection the District Collector instructed to join them in the Social welfare Department's orphanage homes (Anada Nilayams).
- The District Special Olympics Organisation Officer informed that in the District Special Olympics are scheduled to be organized from 4th to 11 January 2011 and requested the A.D Disabled welfare and the Anantapur Mpl Commissioner to extend cooperation in organizing the events.
- The District Collector instructed the Dy EE APS RIC to participate in the engineering works of Housing and bore wells drilling work of DWMA programmes of RIDF and CLDP after obtaining written orders from the concerned department to start the work. Action :: PD Housing, PD DWMA and Dy.E.E APSRIC
