

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 14.2.2011

The District Collector reviewed the progress under formation of Village level committees on effective implementation of WALT Act and instructed

- All the RDOs to instruct the Tahasiladars to ensure periodical beat of tom - tom in villages to aware public on stopping of bore wells drilling in over exploited villages . A message has to be clearly sent to the minds of public that the groundwater potentiality of the district is only 3.50 lakh acres and going for extra irrigation is stealing of water of others. Long term horticulture crops have to be restricted in the district except under HLC ayacut areas.

Excise department Coordination meeting was taken up. Excise Superintendent requested for co-operation of police in Guntakal, Kadiri, C.K. Palli, Ramagiri and Kanaganapalli mandals where more number of cases are filed and deficit excise staff mandals . After reviewing the performance of the department Dist. Collector instructed

- To give the entire list of A Grade centres notices under illicit transportation / manufacturing villages to the D M & H O and to the PD DRDA to tackle the issue from health and women empowerment angles also.
- To call the Commercial tax department also from the next meeting onwards.
- The Excise Department to have convergence with the RDOS to settle any pendency in sending statutory reports.

The District Collector reviewed the progress of all departments present in the meeting and instructed

- ❖ The A.D Mines and Geology to put hard effort to stop san mining by imposing heavy taxes.
- ❖ Mid day meal agencies to open accounts in local banks only. The bankers to accept the proposals of Housing beneficiaries without insisting for minimum balance / deposit keeping in view of the economic status.
- ❖ The LDM to give e-mail to all banks to conduct CBRM meetings I statutorily in the best interest of public as well as banks.
- ❖ The PD DRDA to write letters to VOs and mid day meal agencies to procure red gram to store for the entire year as this February and March months are stock available.
- ❖ The LDM to ensure the presence of bankers in all V.O meetings, mandal level convergence meetings and also to invariably display the 10 negotiable and non negotiable issues with public in front of the banks .
- ❖ The G.M Dairy to monitor the situation of releasing milk cost of beneficiaries through banks to facilitate the bankers to deduct loan component installment amount if assisted under Govt programs.
- ❖ All Officers to standardize all periodical meetings and reports for smooth administration and also conduct surprise visits.

- ❖ LDM to see that all Controlling Officers of banks participate in the next Monday convergence meeting.

Industries Department's single window review meeting and Medical Department's Jawahar Baala Aarogya Raksha programmes were taken up . The DM & HO informed that on February 24th massive dewarming day and hand washing day are scheduled to be organized in all schools, in which, Albendazole tablet will be supplied to all schools to be demonstrated to students. In this connection it has been instructed

1. To administer the tablets only after mid day meals.
2. To issue operational guidelines to implement any programme.
3. To give proper orientation trainings to all students and mid day meal agencies to maintain personnel hygiene .
4. To use the School assembly as a good platform to motivate the young minds towards good healthy habits like daily bathing, twice brushing etc.,
5. To ensure that PHC Medical officers to attend for all V Os meetings and enlighten about personal hygiene in telugu.
6. To instruct all teachers in schools to verify whether the students have cutting nails or not on weekly basis.
7. The DM & HO & PD DRDA to concentrate more on Family planning target achievement an 100 % Institutional deliveries.

The District Collector reviewed the performance of PD MEPMA, DEO, SE PR, DSDO, PD DWMA, DCO, A.D. H & T, A.D Fisheries, Dy. Commissioner of Labour, JD Agrl, DD GWD, DBCWO, DDSW, SE HLC, D.M Civil supplies Corporation, DMNEDCAP and RDOs, and instructed the concerned as follows:

1. DEO to see that honorarium to Vidya Volunteers be paid in time by utilizing maxim funds available. Also to meet the Addl. Joint Collector every Monday before coming to convergence meeting with all updated information on Attendance analysis, payment of honorarium to Volunteers, budget position, Mid meals closing balances, and other issues of the department. It is also instructed to form crisis management committees in all schools to solve all the internal administrative problems without forwarding to higher authorities, who may not be competent to dealt the issues. It is instructed to see that no school is closed due to Census work and all teachers are adhering to the original guidelines of Census of India.
2. SE PR to give compliance report on the agitations rose during rachabanda relating to PR department immediately.
3. To see that NREGS works to commence briskly by proper soft ware administration. And also to see that Kala Jathas are conducted by Water Sheds people in all villages to aware public on; optimal use of Groundwater, growing viable horticulture crops , Animal Husbandry and poultry as alternatives to Agriculture, education to all, and going for institutional credit only for all needs.
4. To put special drive next month to cover the NREGA wage seekers in insurance scheme of labour department.

5. The A D H & T to rectify the irregularities noticed at lower level and also to see that 100% Artisan Credit Cards are distributed to the weavers as , the latest guidelines of banks are not considering the weavers do not have artisan cards for funding.
6. The Joint Director of Agriculture to meet the District Collector with analysis on Groundnut seed variety wise requirement for ensuing Kharif.
7. The District Manager, Civil Supplies Corporation to do surprise inspection to all stock points every week.
8. The AD Horticulture to give power point presentation on viable crops to be grown in the district as horticulture is main growth contributor to district.
9. The RDOs to closely monitor the Census work and also to give written instructions to all concerned , to reject the ration card applications with out previous residential address.

Other issues Discussed in the meeting ::

- The Joint Collector requested the bankers to cooperate VROs when ever they approach to provide unique numbering to Title Deeds available with banks.

Action :: LDM

- The A.D Fisheries requested for providing place in Sai Nagar of Anantapur for fish market.

Action:: ATP Mpl Commissioner.

- The District Collector instructed the DD GWD to write to Govt to get exemption to drill bore wells in the district by amending WALTA Act., keeping in view of the long term horticulture crops grown in the district.

- The District Revenue Officers requested the SE HLC to settle pending dues to the Revenue department being the hiring charges released on reimbursement basis.

Action :: SE HLC.

- The R.M. NABARD informed that a big programme is being launched to provide solar Home lighting in rural areas with NEDCAP tie up, and beneficiaries contribution by banks along with credit . Hence requested the D.M NEDCAP to identify such cases after discussion with R.M.

- The EE Social welfare informed that in Kanekal village construction of residential school work was in progress and some untoward incident took place. Hence requested to instruct the DSP of Kalyandurg, to file case against the issue. Further it is informed that some amounts are due from the Anantapur Mpl Commissioner for the expenditure incurred for the Sri Krishna Devaraya Pancha Sathaabdhi pattabhisheka closing ceremony organized at Penukonda. **Action :: DSP and Atp. Mpl.**
