

The District Collector informed that in view of birth day celebrations of Former Prime Minister, launcher of 20 point programme in the Country late Smt. Indira Gandhi, it is decided by the Govt that Essay writing and elocution competitions to be conducted to High school students at mandal / Municipality level on 12.11.10 , at District level on 15.11.2010 and at state level on 19.11.2010. (i.e. birth day of the eminent persons) . In this connection all the Special Officers, were requested to organize the competitions in consultation with the DEO, MPDOs and MEOs.

As per the efforts of the District collector, 3 retired lecturers of degree college to serve for "VIDYAKU CHEYUTHA" PROGRAMME, were come forward and assured to serve to develop the academic standards of students of this back ward district. District Collector appeal them to develop overall personality of the young generation in the best interest of the nation.

Regarding this topic the District Collector issued the following instructions

- To achieve 100% physical attendance of the pupil at this stage and mental attendance later on.
- To develop sports and games skills in students.
- To cut down watching of Television in evenings in schools and hostels.
- To improve ambiance in schools and hostels.

The District Collector released a poster relating to covering of out of school children in education, as per the request of the P.O. Rajiv Vidya Mission.

Review on the uniform rainfall received in the entire district on 8.11.10 and its impact on receipt of water to all minor irrigation sources was taken up and instructed:

- To analysis the ground water recharge in the district for the rains in the month of November :: DD GWD
- To access any crop loss, house damages , or any other losses to be treated with relief immediately.
- To organise press meet on the latest water position in all water harvesting structures constructed in the district.
- To give detailed report each source wise water position :: SE MI and HLC

The District level committee meeting of Handloom weavers and bankers was taken up in the meeting and the proposed resolutions for issuing of 100% cash credit from NABARD i.e. refinance from APCOB was accepted.

The PO RVM explained about the celebration of Child Rights week from 14th to 21st of this month as per the circular communicated and requested or co-operation from line departments and participation from all Special Officers. In this connection it has been instructed by the District Collector to organize the programme successfully and to felicitate the students who got 100% of attendance , 60% in academic filed , and good

record in games and sports and also to link up the programme with the medical department programme relating to child health.

The District Collector reviewed the status of 20 point programme implementation in the district in view of the meeting scheduled to be held on 10.11.10 as the 20 PP Committee Chairman is visiting the district on the above date. In this connection it has been instructed all concerned officers to participate in the meeting without fail and also to see that the progress of all departments should not be less than 80 %.

The District co-ordination committee meeting of Dairy Development was convened during the meeting and it has been informed that the District is in First position in milk procurement in the state has been explained by the District Manager with power point presentation. In this connection it has been instructed to analyze the percentage of milch animal in financing from Government departments, particularly in SHG finance and the proportional increase in milk procurement, and also to cover the animal under insurance schemes.

District Collector reviewed the status of Collector Camp Office references pending with the District Officers and instructed to settle all pending 227 issues by submitting final report to Collector's Camp Office by next Monday. The pendency status was reviewed Department wise, and informed that the information is available in website and instructed to make use of the information to settle all cases by next week .

The District Collector reviewed the arrangements at Puttaparthi on the eve of Birth Day celebrations of Bhasgavan Sri Satya Sai Baba on 23rd of this month and instructed:

- To arrange for medical facilities for the VIPs and general public to be looked after the DM&HO, Superintendent GGH and Programme Officer AIDS Control Society.
- To complete all works by 16th and to give daily progress of the works by ED BC Corpn.,
- To reserve the AP Tourism Guest houses for the VIPs accommodation.
- To take up any repair works to Schools and Hostels where General accommodation is planned, and also to declare holidays on those days, to schools and hostels.
- To work in coordination of the Public Health, PR, R&B departments.

Other instructions issued by the District Collector during the meeting:

- To furnish the list of Driver available in all officers where Govt vehicles were condemned and the drivers are idle, in view of necessity of services in other departments to the District Revenue Officer.
- To deploy good revenue staff in Mudigubba Tahasildar office in all cadres to improve the performance in view of large geographical boundaries of the mandal. :: DRO / RDO Penukonda
- To collect information on in the monthly reports participation of MRPs in VO/MS meetings at village / mandal level. :: PORVM / PD DRDA

- To sensitize all cadre officers in revenue department in managing the natural calamities situation, and to provide relief measures as early as possible even in hours in serving the public. :: DRO and RDOs
- Give sites to construct libraries at Hindupur, Kadiri, Bathalpalli and C.K . Palli madal head quarters.
- To form road to Greenery developing Society at Lepakshi, and 5.00 acres of land to the Aluvera industrial farm.
- To invite Auto financing firms to the District Credit Committee meeting scheduled on tomorrow to counsel on indiscriminate financing to Auto rickshaws.
- To restrict the Private Colleges running against the guidelines. RIO and MPL. Commissioners
- To attend for Prajaa Vaani Grievance cell by all District Officers without sending the subordinate officers.
- To make use the Convergence meeting plat for to sort out inter departmental issues, as some long pending issues are being brought to the notice of the District Collector on some other occasions.
- To inform the date of meetings scheduled to Tahasildars and MPDOs to all officers to make use the meeting by all.
- To analyse the issue of Chilamathur Mandal Dheemaketha palli School with number of students from each village with distance to them.
- To immediately ground the units sanctioned by S.C Corporation during the year 2006 relating to Kanaganapalli and C.K Palli mandal beneficiaries. ::LDM
- To go for vertical type of constructions of Govt Buildings where there is scarcity of land.
- To give latest report on the progress of work at Pendekallu and Chagallu reservoir.
- To get permission for transportation of sand for construction activity I the district. :: AD Mines & Geology and DD GWD.

ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING

- The District Medical and Health officer in formed that the Govt is launching Jawahar Bala Aarogya Raksha scheme i.e. issuing of health identify , check up and referral cards , on 14.11.10 at Kurugunta Residential school and after 25th in the entire district as per the fixed scheduled .
- The District Revenue Officer raised the previous issue of putting online progress report under the RTI Act (as only 18 departments were updated information as on the date of review) and requested all officers to up date information in online immediately, to avoid any legal complications.

- The CEO Zilla Parishad informed that world bank financed programme to construct Compound walls to schools buildings was sanctioned and requested to furnish the list of schools requiring compound walls. :: EE SW
- The EE Social Welfare raised the previous issue of furnishing the resolutions of the Gram Panchayats to demolish the old builds to take up new constructions as the Reddipalli and Amadagur resolutions yet to be received. :: CEOZP
- The Lead District Manager informed that there is provision of financing to students after intermediate education to the families having income upto Rs. 4.00 lakhs, for which the income and the parents signatures are to be counter signed by the concerned tahasildars. Requested all Special Officers to popularize the concept in mandals/ villages .
- The Assistant Director Handlooms and Textiles requested for additional finance of Rs 15000/- from Housing depart to the weavers. For this it has been instructed to furnish the entire housing beneficiaries list to Tahasildars on tomorrow Revenue Officers conference to identify the weaver beneficiary. :: PD Housing and A H & T
- The P.D Housing requested the RDOs to conduct enquiries in the mandals where more than 200 houses were sanctioned. It is also informed that the beneficiaries list were publicized in all prominent places in mandals.
- The Project Director Women and Child welfare informed that "JOB MELA" is being organized on 10.11.10 at Bala Mahila Pragathi Pranganam from 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM in coordination with the PD DRDA to select 1200 candidates for various jobs.
- The Pranganam Officer requested to take up land leveling works in the premises in view of the proposed Jobmela as there is stagnation of rainy water . It is also requested to take up planatation programme in the premises. Ir is also requested the DBCWO to release the previous due amount of Rs 11.00 laksh. :: DBCWO, PD DWMA and Mpl. Commissioner.
- The DTWO requested to transfer some land to construct Girijan Bhavan in Old Town Medical Office premises. It is also requested to alienate land to construct College Tribal Girls Hostels at Kadiri and Anantapur :: DM & HO and RDO, ATP and PKD.

The Project Director DWMA gave a power point presentation on recent rains- and its impact in storage of water in the water harvest structures. It is requested to have sufficient works in the shelf in all GPs and also to follow the standing instruction by all the concerned officers that every month second Friday will be the day for inspection of NREGS works exclusively by the Special Officers.
