

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 26.09.2011

Initiating the meeting, the District Collector took up the discussion on arrangements for C.M. visit Programme scheduled on 07.10.2011 and issued instructions to the S.E., Public Health, S.E., TBPHLC, Municipal Commissioners of Rayadurg & Gooty(i/c) to submit programme schedule immediately. And also The District Collector discussed on issues raised by Hon'ble Member of Parliament of Anantapur with E.E., Irrigation and Public Health and SE PR Official and instructed to solve the problems immediately.

Inter-Departmental convergence issues raised

- District Revenue Officer discussed with related Departments about minimum wages at present in process and newly proposed wages. The District Medical and Health Officer has been questioned if the contract workers working in PHCs are paid minimum labour. The District Medical and Health Officer briefed that it will be enquired and detailed report will be submitted.
- The Joint Collector, Anantapur convened District Level Co-Ordination Committee meeting on World Agriculture Census 2010-11 and she instructed all the Revenue Divisional Officers to take necessary action to complete the enumeration work of WAC before 31.10.2011.
- The District Collector took up discussion about Bank linkages for Urban self employment to disabled Self Help Groups with P.D., Mepma (Urban IKP). P.D., Mepma was instructed to provide Urban SHG Centre buildings to run ICDS Anganwadi schools upto allotment of municipal sites for Anganwadi school buildings. PD, Mepma requested cooperation from DM&HO Officials to conduct Medical Camps in Urban areas. The District Collector instructed to make publicity of certain Govt. Programmes by inviting the Other than Municipal Official and also SC, ST residing areas should be developed with basic infrastructures and more than 15% of grants from General funds should be spent for this purpose.
- DD Adult Education /Sakshara Bharathi Mission Officer requested that Volunteers may be provided from NREGS Programme, VSS, Adarsha rythulu, Anganwadi teachers, Minority Madarsa school teachers, District Tribal welfare, District youth welfare, DRDA, DEO, SSA, Handlooms & Textiles,

Urban IKP at micro level for Adult Literacy Programme. The District Collector instructed all concerned District Officers to submit the list of volunteers before 15.10.2011. Division level Avagahana Sadassu may be convened to Volunteers after CM Programme on 07.10.2011. Panchayat Raj Departments should mobilize the Programme for achievement of 100% Literacy.

- Joint Collector discussed on issues of Mandal level convergence meetings. The District Collector instructed to improve coordination mechanism at Mandal level and solve major issues on Housing and NREGS at Mandal level itself. All the Special Officers are instructed to continue Friday visits (Melukolupu).
- The Treasury Officer instructed to look after the implementation of 13th Finance commission orders at Mandal level.
- District Medical & Health Officer informed that the sanitation in some areas of Tadipatri and Singanamala Mandals is very poor, due to which, Dengue fever cases are being recorded in large number.
- Joint Director, Agriculture briefed that Bengalgram seed is essential at present. Farmers are removing Groundnut crop which is spoiled due to lack of timely rains and going for sowings of Bengalgram crop as substitute crop.
- The District Collector instructed the Joint Director Agriculture to prepare a report on drought conditions prevailing as there is very less rainfall during September month which is not occurred since last 10 years.
- Chief Planning Officer is requested to write a letter to the Principal Secretary Planning from Collector side requesting for necessary instructions to the concerned officials for continuous weekly based flow of information relating to rainfall, humidity, temperature being received at APSDMS from Automatic Weather Stations installed in 63 mandals in the district as there is seeming crop damages due adverse seasonal conditions prevailing in the September month in the district.
- Discussion about Grievance cells at Mandals is done. The District Collector instructed all the Special Officers that Grievance day should be effective and confidence should be created among public about the Mandal level grievance cells and positive motivation is needed. Confidence building

among public is most important. The message should go down to the levels. Data entry of Prajavani petitions should be done immediate using software provided by the NIC. Separate passwords have already been given to Special Officers to monitor the prajavani petitions often.

- From October 10th to 25th Gramsabhas will be conducted and all the petitions will be redressed at Mandal level.
- Lastly District Revenue Officer instructed all the Revenue Divisional Officers to submit immediately crop loans lists.
