

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 2.1.2012

At the outset, District Collector reviewed the Drought situation in the District with the line departments.

1. Regarding NREGS implementation in the District PD DWMA informed that in spite of prevalence of severe drought in the district number of wage seekers attending for works is less than one lakh, hence requested all the Special officers to put sincere efforts to improve the number of wage seekers attending for works to avoid migrations from the districts. It is also informed that the MPDOs should utilize the services of Technical Assistant in the mandals up to the maximum level.
2. Regarding Drinking water, issue of Sigampalli Thanda village of Atmakur mandal received in G.C. petition was discussed and the District Medical and Health Officer informed that he visited along with his team to the Thanda all preventive steps from medical department will be taken up. As the sanitation is very poor in the village. He requested the DPO to issue instructions to the local bodies to keep the village clean as the drains stagnation is the main cause of severe ill health of the village. The Joint Collector informed that as per the reports from RDOs 23 villages in Anantapur Division, 54 in Dharmavaram and 15 in Penukonda are facing Drinking water problem hence it is instructed to consolidate all the issues at SE RWS level to arrive at solutions.
3. Regarding raising of Fodder, the J.D Animal husbandary informed that out of 88 tanks in the District fodder was raised in 11 tanks and all measures are being taken up to meet the fodder demand in the District.

Instructions issued during the meeting::

- There will a separate review on NREGS in every District Convergence meetings.
- To speed up all works relating to fodder development in the District and also to take up construction of cattle ponds. It is also instructed to take all steps to retain all fodder stocks available in the district without crossing the borders of the District to meet the future demands. Further it is instructed to take up dug out ponds, mini percolation tanks and cattle ponds in NREGS works.
- To give wide publicity on prevention of cattle deaths for consuming poisonous feed via slides in cinema theatres, FM Radio etc,.
- The failed Agriculture bore well to invariably be filled to avoid untoward incidents in the villages. The DD GWD is instructed to prepare slides for this issue.
- The RDOs to coordinate all the issues relating to Drinking water, Fodder etc.
- The RDOs to inspect Cinema Theatres periodically, and should stop issuing / renewal of licenses for any non fulfillment of safety measures. Nursing Homes safety aspect

to be taken care by the DM & HO, RDOs and corporate Schools and Hostels by the DEO respectively to be held responsible.

- The PD housing to give entire list of housing progress stage wise to sort out.
- The TRANSCO department to speed up all energisation works of Indiramma housing colonies.
- The EDs of SC / ST / BC corporations are instructed to give sanctions immediately for the entire budget allotted to their departments.
- The SE HLC is instructed to see that all measures to be taken to release water to Pulivendula branch canal on 4th of this month.
- All the MPDOs to be instructed to lock all the school building which are about to rundown and also to inspect all School and hostel buildings in the mandals and report compliance to CEO ZP for necessary action. The MPDOs are competent to give certification of the stage of the building to demolish.
- All the executive agencies involving in construction of school / hostel buildings to speed up their work in the places where the buildings are in dilapidated condition.
- All the District Officers to involve press people to reach positive message to public regarding the performance of the departments by giving wide publicity in newspapers, distribution of pamphlets etc by utilizing the interest funds available with the departments.
- The LDM and Police Department to put efforts to reduce the A category Grievances Cell Petitions which are huge in number. For this it is instructed the LDM can give user id and pass words to the Controlling banks to immediate online redressal updation.
- The Revenue Department Officers to invariably inspect hostels periodically
- Slides to be prepared and exhibited in Cinema Theaters on 1. Cattle Deaths for consuming poisonous feed. 2. Hazards of open failed agriculture borewells. 3. Safety measures in cinema theaters / schools / hospitals. 4. Explosives prevention by the concerned officers.
- All the District Officers are instructed to take prior approval of the Dist. Collector to give Fixed Deposits to banks. Any deviation to this will be viewed as financial irregularities of the concerned officer.

A Power point Presentation on State Milk Mission was given by PD DRDA, on the PALA PRAGATHI KENDRALU being implemented in the district with the teamwork of Animal Husbandry department. To improve the milk productivity in the District, the Dist. Collector instructed the Banks and Dairy department to extend co-operation for providing backward and forward linkages to make the State Milk Mission a success in the District. It is also

instructed to take up the scheme in MBO method (Management by Objective) by splitting the targets into lowest possible periods, and this item will be reviewed periodically by the Dist. Administration.

During the meeting a special focus on amenities to be provided to the physically challenged persons to approach Offices was taken up and it is instructed

1. To construct ramp to all offices with public participation.
2. During the Monday Prajavaani programme the AD Disabled welfare to arrange mobile office in Collectorate in the ground floor itself.
3. The PD DRDA to keep one vehicle exclusively to take the persons to Govt Hospital for Physical examinations instead of asking them to come to SADARAM camps.
4. For all Beneficiary oriented programmes it is to be ensured over & above reserved 3% is achieved for PHC coverage, and also all departments to prepare separate list of PHC / SC / ST / and other communities

Issues Discussed during the meeting.

- The Special Officer, Kudair/ PD MEPMA informed that in Brahmnapalli (v) the leprosy patients are residing in a separate colony and cultivating dry land horticulture crops to an extent of 23 acres.. Due to inability to work in the farms they are approaching for take up land development programmes under NREGS to their colony, hence requested to take up it as a special case. For this the PD DWMA instructed to send the feasible proposals to consider their case.
- The Special Officer, Agali / A D Sericulture, Madakasira sought clarification on taking up of de-silting works in the tanks, as per the public demand. For this the PD DWMA informed that now all works are open and any work can be taken up. Another issue relating to Housing also raised regarding payment due to Housing colony beneficiaries of Hulikera Village which was drawn in the name of Halikera (double payment), need to be rectified and the pending due to be paid by the PD Housing.
- The Joint Director of A.H requested for cooperation of Banks and DD Dairy for inauguration of 500 mini dairies in the District. For this the District Collector instructed to see that the mini dairies to start working with in no time.
- The Special Officer, Peddavadugur / APD DRDA informed that there is scarcity in Konapuram viillage and requested the SE RWS to rectify the problem.
- The RDO, Penukonda , informed that there is power cut in all villages including street lights, causing trouble to public life, hence requested the SE TRANSCO and DPO to rectify the problem.

- The Special Officer, Hindupur / J.D Sericulture informed that there is severe drinking water problem in Mittameedipalli, Gollapuram, & Chowlur villages.
- The Addl. Joint Collector raised the issue of jurisdictional clarification required between DPO and SE RWS to provided drinking water to public, as in Kalyanadurg some areas are neglected by both the departments causing drinking water problem to public.
- The Special Officer, Kanaganapali, / Dist Minority welfare Officer informed that proposals to solve drinking water problem in 3 village of the mandal were submitted to the SE RWS 3 months back for which there is no action was taken so far by the line departments.
- The Special Officer, Puttaparthi / ED B.C Corporation informed that there is problem of OHSR in Pedaballi village which need immediate action.
- The Addl. Joint Collector requested the Welfare departments to finalise the proposals of adopting of hostels by all officers and head masters to get good pass percentage in SSC results 2012.
- The Special Officer, Tadipathri / SDC HNSS informed that Indiramma Colony constructed in Phase III in Bugga village do not have power supply even though deposits were made along back, so requested for the early action in the matter.
- The PD DWMA informed that in Bommnahal Mandal, the Police Station House Officer is refusing to register case being filled by the APM for the irregularities in Uddehal Village. Hence requested for early necessary action.
- The PD DWMA informed that under Indira Prabha and Indira Jala Prabha though deposits were paid to TRANSCO department work is still pending in 689 cases, hence requested the SE TRANSCO to speed up the works to complete immediately
- The District Medical & Health Officer requested the SE TRANSCO to immediately reconnect power to the PHC to maintain cold chain to medicines.
- The Project Director Housing requested all the Special Officers to verify the applications received in Rachaband II and also raised an issue of Toll gate charges at NH A4 imposed to Government Vehicles. All the Officers are requested to give the list of Vehicle (s) with registration numbers to the District Revenue Officer for necessary action.
