

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 11.7.2011

The District Collector (I/c) at the outset informed that it is decided to organize licensed farmer's I D cards distribution programme in the District by the H'ble Minister for Revenue & H'ble Minister for Primary Education 14th and 15th of this month at Revenue Division points. It is scheduled to launch the programme on 14th morning at Penukonda, afternoon in Dharmavaram, and on 15th morning in Anantapur . To organize the programme successfully it is instructed :

1. All RDOs to get sanction letters from the concerned banks well in advance.
2. All departments implementing beneficiary oriented schemes to arrange for distribution of assets to the newly sanctioned beneficiaries.
3. All departments to organize stalls in the premises of the venues where the programmes are being planned and to be in touch with the Revenue Divisional Officers.

A review was taken on the mandal level convergence issues and all concerned District Heads are requested to take necessary action as following

- APSRTC to provide bus facility to D.K. Thanda and Goridindla village high school students to attend in time to Muttala ZPHS of Atmakur mandal..
- PD DWMA to get permission from Government to enhance the ceiling of 125 wage days in needy areas (Rayadurg) of the District and also to provide provision of altering the sanctioned works in Fodder development programme as requested by MPDO Mudigubba.

Other instructions issued in the meeting:

1. The EE SW to give the entire list of proposals sent to Govt for sanction of new works in the district to the AJC.
2. The PD Women & Child welfare to give the entire list of candidates, who appeared for AW worker posts in CD form to the DIO by tomorrow 10.00 AM for further processing.
3. The DEO to give the school point wise text books distributed list to the Dist. Collector.
4. The PO RVM and DM & HO to come with action plan for the next meeting on Jawahar Bala Arogya Raksha programme.
5. To redress all the A and B category petitions received in Prajaavani Grievance cell ,as there are 114 A - Category and 164 B - category pending in the district as on date.
6. To remind all District Officers to attend Convergence meetings without fail .

Other issues Discussed in the meeting ::

- The Additional Joint Collector raised an issue of releasing of amount for construction of ISLs in Non - INDIRAMMA colony in Korlakunta village of Brahmasamudram Mandal.It is also requested to constuct new toilet block in ZPHS of Chennampalli of Kambadur madnal.Action :: SE RWS & EE SW
- The Addl. Joint Collector raised an issue of formation of Roads by PR department under NREGS in Elachintala village of Kundurpi mandal and Siri Thanda of Kambadur mandal. The RDO Dharmavaram also infnoremd the similar work from Nagaluru to Gotlur in Dharmavaram mandal. Action :: SE PR.
- The Revenue Divl. Officer, Penukonda requested to sort out the drinking water scarcity in old housing colony of R.Ananthapuram village of Madakasira mandal. Action :: SE RWS

- The Revenue Divl. Officer, Penukonda raised an issue of providing infrastructure facilities i.e. electricity in Chowtipalli where 281 houses have been completed .
Action :: PD Housing & SE TRANSCO
- The Revenue Divl. Officer, Penukonda informed that the M.I Tank at Gudipalli village of Somandepalli mandal needs some repairs and hence requested to take up the work under NREGS programme.
Action :: PD DWMA & MPDO Somandepalli.
- The D.D. Social Welfare informed that the sanction of post matric scholarships (renewals) to be completed by 31.7.11 online as per the instructions of the Government. Hence requested the RDOs to instruct the Tahasildars and MPDOs to complete the work. In this connection the AJC instructed to conduct ASWO circle wise Govt Colleges Principal's meetings to get the work done and also to give press note to that effect. It is also instructed to invite the student organisations for the above said meetings. The Aadhar card number of any PMS sanctioned student should invariably be included in applications as per the instructions of GOI. Action DD SW, DTWO and DBCWO.
- The J.D Animal Husbandry informed that the anti rabies vaccine is being supplied to all municipalities and Gram Panchayats to treat the Dog caught, hence requested to utilise the vaccine .
- The DIO, Anantapur informed that website updation has been done only by 4 departments and latest updations are yet to be received from DBCWO, DD SW, Minority Welfare, Minority Corn., J.D A.H., DM & HO, SE Irrigation DRDA, DWMA, DEO, JD Agrl. Housing, Horticulture, SE RWS, APMIP. In this connection the District Collector(I/c) instructed the defaulters to send the information invariably. This subject should not be pending by next Monday. Further it is also informed that website maintenance charges are also due from DRDA, DWMA, JD Agrl (ATMA funds), JD AH, PO RVM, PD Dhousing, A.D. Horticulture and ATP Mpl. Commissioner @ 25000/- each. Action :: All concerned officers.
- The EE Social Welfare raised the previous issue of legal complication being raised by private individual to construct SW Residential College in Kanekal. In this connection the District Collector(I/c) instructed the RDO Dharmavaram to read the case and seek legal remedy.
Action:: RDO DMM
- The RDO, Dharmavaram informed that during last year uniforms were not supplied to the boarders of Women Welfare Baalasanam due to non payment of stitching charges, and hence requested not to repeat the same during this year. Action :: PD W & CW
