

Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 15.6.2010 at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur

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The District Collector at the outset congratulated all the Special Officers, Agrl. Officers Revenue Officials for smooth conduct and completion of I phase of Seed Distribution programme in the district and reviewed each special Officer on the balance of Groundnut seed available in all distribution points. In this connection the following instructions were issued .

- ❖ to frame charges to those Agriculture Officers who failed to send physical verification reports in time ( i.e. Narpla, Gooty, Dharmavaram, Ramagiri and Kanaganaplli )
- ❖ To access the original requirement of seed each variety wise for the further phases of Seed distribution programme to be projected to State level.
- ❖ To adhere to the same guidelines followed in I phase to further phases of distribution also by rectifying any minute defects noticed.
- ❖ To balance the number of counters to be organized based on the demand and flow of farmers to the distribution points.
- ❖ To reject and return the low quality seed invariably to the stock points.
- ❖ To book 6 A cases for unauthorized transportation of seed .
- ❖ To take all possible steps to prevent seed being diverted.
- ❖ To test the quality of seed at district level also in the available testing laboratories.
- ❖ To test seed germination by any of the Agriculture Officer .
- ❖ To balance the K 6 seed varieties from non requirement area to requirement area with intra departmental interference.
- ❖ To organize Next phases on 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of this month after sufficient stock of seed availability. To give wide publicity by beat of Tom Tom in villages to this extent
- ❖ To do stock verification of seed by Agriculture Officers and Special Officers and keep all bills books in strong rooms of Police Stations, and be proactive in all distribution centres.
- ❖ To avoid excess billing .
- ❖ To attest on the overleaf of every bill book by the authorized signatory and affix stamp.
- ❖ To take care of the illegal transportation of seed by the Agencies.
- ❖ To return all PPBs collected from farmers duly assigning Unique numbers by 17<sup>th</sup> of this month.
- ❖ To speedup the activities of personnel deployed in Seed distribution monitoring wing at J. D.A's office.
- ❖ To notify to public all storing places in the District.
- ❖ To file cases against the seized stocks immediately and also to take action on illegal transportation of G. Nut seed.

Review on Prajaptham issues redressal status Department wise has been taken up by the District Collector. It is also informed that the Hble Chief Minister is holding a Video Conference review on 21.6.2010 on the redressal status . Hence instructed all officers to furnish the Latest progress reports to chief Planning Officer by 16<sup>th</sup>. It is also informed that a special review meeting will be there on 19.6.2010 at DWMA hall with all the defaulting officers in sending the Action Taken Reports and issued the following Department wise instructions :

1. SE RWS and CEO ZP to stabilize the issues and filter them after grant from TFC funds and the Chief Planning Officer to peruse the issues as the Drinking water works are being sanctioned under ACDP funds.
2. SE TRANSCO to sort all issues like preparation of estimates and send the progress report at the earliest.
4. PD DRDA to sanction all eligible pensions proposals received and also new loans under Pavala Vaddi.
5. PD Housing to settle all new sanctions and other discrepancies earlier.
6. The DPO has been appreciated by the Collector for quick response in sending the reports to Chief Planning Officer

All department to show progress in sorting out the issues and furnish compliance reports immediately to the Chief Planning Officer.

#### OTHER ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING

- The District Collector instructed the Revenue Officials to take care of the backlog mandals in providing Unique numbering to PPBs and low progress in Epic programme. And instructed to see that the PPB unique numbering to be at more than 75%. It is also instructed to handover the census house listing materials in Tahasildar Officers. Action:- DRO and RDOs.
- The Joint Director of Animal Husbandry requested for allotting of one stall in Rythu Bazaar for sale of Fish and Meat. Action :-AD Marketing.
- Sri Satya Sai drinking water works Engineer requested for stabilizing the power supply at CBR at Tadimarri and at Control point of Kanumukkala substation for Puttparthi pipe line. Action SE TRANSCO.
- The District Collector requested for furnishing day wise progress at Dharmavaram Drinking water works in Town and also at CBR work providing . Action :: EE PH
- To appoint the G.M AGROs as Super Special Officer to Kadiri East mandals.
- The PO Rajiv Vidya Missison requested all special officers to participate in the Samoohika Aksharabhyasam programme on 21<sup>st</sup> in all mandals and to instruct the Head masters to see that the enrolment data to reflect in this programme. Action ::Special Officers and DEO
- The District Collector instructed to redress all discrepancies being received in Prajaavani programme on "SAKSHARA BHARATHI PROGRAMME'. Action ::DD Adult education

- The PO RVM briefly explained the progress under "BADI BAATA" programme and after 20<sup>th</sup> meeting of Head Masters latest report will be submitted to the District Collector. In this regard it has been instructed to closely monitor the programme and see that maximum number be enrolled in the programme : Action:: PO RVM
- The District Collector instructed to fix responsibility to bench mates and neighbors to the drop out children to re enroll.
- The DFO (SF) to fully utilize the ensuing rainy season in plantation programme and also to operationalise the facilities being providing by the District administration to improve the plant population in this district. All Students and NREGS wage seekers to plant and protect the trees @ 2 per head. It is also instructed to transport the seedlings to the Institutions / villages where plantation programme are scheduled and explore the possibility of using Rs 500/- from Gram panchayat / MPP funds / Administrative cost of NREGS.  
Action DFO (SF), DPO and PD DWMA
- The MPDOS to be involved in massive plantation programmes.  
Action : CEO ZP.
- The Joint Collector raised an issue that the tank bed areas are being encroached for housing in urban areas and requested to take up bloc level plantation in these areas to prevent the phenomena. In the similar manner the RDO, Penukonda also informed that the same case with Gorantla mandal Headquarters also. Action DFO
- The District collector instructed to organize cultural programmes in all villages with the song and Drama division of public relation department on the script prepared by the Ground Water Department on the Ground water levels in the district.

During the meeting a Boucher published by the DWMA on Rain water harvesting taken up and to be continued in the in the District has been released by the District Collector .

The District Collector instructed all officers to give latest report on redressed status on Prajapatham issues to the Chief Planning Officer invariably by 16<sup>th</sup> in view of the H'ble Chief Minister's Video Conference scheduled on 21-06-2010 from 4.30 PM to 6.30 PM .
