

Minutes of Convergence meeting held on 31.01.2011

The District Revenue Officer reviewed the progress under online updating of RTI act progress report for the month of December 2010 and Annual report of 2010 and remarked that only 28 depts were up dated information. Hence it is instructed

- all remaining officers to update the data immediately keeping in view of ensuing assembly sessions.
- To update the information under Public Information Officer under item 17 and also to send a copy of updated information to District Collectorate.
- The Additional Joint Collector may inspect any office surprisingly on implementation of RTI act as the District Collector desires to know the actual status in the district.

The Joint Collector congratulated all the district officers and appreciated the team work done for making the H'ble C.M visit successful in the District.

The Joint Collector requested the officers to give feed back on the ongoing Rachabanda Programme. The following issues were brought to the notice of the District Administrations by some of the Special Officers.

- ❖ The RDO, Dharmavaram/ Super Special Officer, informed that in Obulampalli (v) of C.K.Palli mandals there is an issue relating to Drinking water. Hence requested the SE RWS to participate in the Rachabanda Programme of Rappthadu, as per the request of the H'ble MLA . It is also informed that in C.K.Palli, Kanaganapalli, Ramagiri and in Tanakal mandals there are many issues relating to Drinking water and Housing . Hence requested the concerned District Officers to instruct the mandal level officers to invariably participate during Rachabanda programmes. Regarding this issue the PD DRDA and DWMA were also interacted and informed that on behalf of District Administration the RDO, Dharmavaram has assured the public to solve all issues relating to Housing and Drinking water by the end of February. Hence requested the concerned officers to put effort in that direction.
- ❖ The Special Officer, Rolla & Agali/ PO RVM informed that there are some issues relating to Housing and Pavalavaddi programme were sorted out at mandal level.
- ❖ The Special Officer, Rappthadu / AD Horticulture _ I raised an issue that there is an pending issue of Prajapatham , i.e. Housing and Installation of Electric Transformer in Boginepalli and Palacherla villages has created a little problem Hence requested to solve the issue. Action :: PD Housing & SE TRANSCO.
- ❖ The Special Officer, Putlur / D.Y.W.O informed that in Yellutla village public requested for formation of Roads & supply of 3 phase power supply entire day. Action::SE RANSCO, SE R&B
- ❖ The Special Officer, Kudair / DD AE informed that in Korrakodu village the housing payments were not done by the V.O and became a problem. Hence requested the PD housing to solve the issue at the earliest. Further it is also informed that there are pending Drinking water issues raised in Prajapatham programme in Cholasamudram, Nagula guddam and Karutlapalli villages of the mandal were created some noise in Rachabanda Programmes. Action ::PD Housing & SE RWS

- ❖ The Special officer, Puttaparthi & Kothacheruvu / ED BC Corporation informed that there are pending issues of Prajapatham relating to TRANSCO and requested to solve before Rachabanda programmes. It is also informed that in the district the payments made by V.Os are mainly at basement level are under discrepancies, due to which the houses completed at roof level are also under pending by the housing corporation, has to be sorted at the earliest. Action :: SE TRANSCO & PD Housing.
- ❖ The Special Officers, Tadimarri informed that in Ekapadamapalli village the sanction letters to housing beneficiaries were issued during Rachabanda programme but the beneficiaries were asking for payment of 1st installment amount. In Pinnadari village also payments made by V.O are not in receipt to the original beneficiaries. Action : PD Housing .
- ❖ The Special Officer, Kalyanadurg informed that in Dodagatta village Prajapatham issue of installation of transformer is pending which may become issue during Rachabanda hence requested the SE TRANSCO to install transformer at the earliest. Further 350 houses were sanctioned 2 years back in the village which were not yet processed, hence requested PD Housing to issue ID numbers to those beneficiaries to avoid complications in Rachabanda. Action :: SE TRANSCO & PD Housing
- ❖ The P.D Women and Child welfare informed that the Distribution of GCPS bonds to beneficiaries is taken up only in Anantapur district is being appreciated by all.
- ❖ The Special Officer, Amadagur raised an issue that the new houses to the beneficiaries were sanctioned only under G.O 171, remaining not yet sanctioned. For that the PD Housing informed that the minute data entry mistakes to be rectified for sanctioning new houses, which will be completed in a few days.

A review on Collector's Camp Officer notes was conducted by the Joint Collector and instructed officers to clear off the pendency.

A review on Prajaavani Petitions redressal status was taken up by the Joint Collector and instructed officers to reduce the A category petitions to the maximum extent.

Other issues Discussed in the meeting ::

- The Project Director Housing informed that 10000 pamphlets explaining the advantages of timely completion houses (with cost analysis) sanctioned by Govt. were published and ready for distribution to public .
- The Joint Collector raised an issue that the certification issued by the Revenue authorities in-lieu of bifurcation of existing family members to sanction houses may have a problem while uploading sanction order hence requested the PD Housing to have revised the soft ware package by state level authorities.
Action :: PD Housing.
- The Joint Collector informed that while sending proposals for sanctioning of pensions to old age people the age quoted either in Ration cards or Voter Ids may be treated as criteria for consideration by the MPDOs.

- The P.D Housing informed that in Uravakonda mandal to solve the housing payments issue a inter face conciliation with V.O (Vs.) beneficiaries was organized which lead to some amicable understanding between the both . Hence requested all officers to take up such measure when ever issues relating to non payment of amount by V.Os come up.
- The Joint Collector requested all officers to ensure that 100% receipts for applications of Rachabanda to reach the beneficiaries invariably to build confidence among public. It is also instructed to do some preparatory exercises before conducting the meetings towards the direction of solving the probable issues those may arise. It is also to ensure that no banker is insisting for Fixed deposit while lending to SHGs. It is informed that Special care to be taken on housing issues in the district as the H'ble C.M has assured of deputing the MD Housing to solve all problems of Anantapur District Housing Department.
- The Additional Joint Collector requested all officers to ensure 100% distribution of pay orders along with sanction letters of housing in Rachabanda, as pay orders are equally important to sanction letters.
- The PD DRDA requested all special officers to ensure that the Pavala vaddi account payee crossed cheques are being handed over directly to the concerned SHGs.
- The PD DWMA requested all officers (1) to process any issue raised by public or public representatives in Rachabanda programme to the district administration to take further necessary action. (2) to ensure that all works were commenced under NREGA in all villages. Any notice of even a single migration from any village will be viewed seriously and action will be initiated against the filed level officers concerned. (3) Any visit of State Minister to Rachabnada to be informed to the local public representatives.
- The Joint Collector requested to supply uninterrupted power supply to those mandals where enrolment for Aadhaar cards is under process. Action :: SE TRANSCO
- The Additional Joint Collector requested the Special Officers to pursue with the MPDOs and Tahasildars to complete the inspection of Scholarship applications at the earliest , keeping in view of ensuing March month. As the user IDs and Passwords were issued to all inspecting officers, the applications may be processed online. The DD Social welfare, DBCWO and DTWO to coordinate in Anantapur town as the applications are huge in number and also to give requisition to Civil supplies corporation to extend time to pay amount for release of PDS rice stocks, as the stocks are almost exhausted in all hostels.
