

**Minutes of the Convergence meeting held by the District Collector on 16.11.2009 at
DWMA Conference hall, Anantapur**

The District Collector at the beginning of the meeting explained about the importance of Standardization of procedures like conducting Surprise visits to villages and simplified social audit mechanism. A team of Students of America visited our District to study the NREGP programme implementation, as it has become a programme of international importance. After that the Dist Collector interacted with all the Special Officers present for the meeting on Friday surprise visits to villages / mandals and also conduct of last Mandal convergence meeting at TRASCO offices. During the review it has been instructed by the District Collector as follows:

1. To complete settlement of electricity deaths compensation for all the pending 72 cases by next week end. This item will be reviewed every week till cases are finalization
Action:: SE TRANSCO, RDOs and Special Officers
2. To take up institutional plantation programmes on a large scale. To address all MEOS to take up plantation programmes
Action :: All Special Officers, PD DWMA , SE Housing & DEO
3. To see that from Dec 1st onwards the NREGP should be speeded up and also to ensure the participation of students of our colleges and universities also to take part in NREGP to improve the performance of the scheme as the progress of the scheme is personally reviewed by the H'ble Prime Minister. **Action:: PD DWMA**
4. The C.Ds containing the details of housing beneficiary should be made available for purchase of public in MPDOs & Tahasildar Officers. Ensure that the CDs are unalterable.
Action : PD Housing.
5. To organise a special drive for regularizing the irregular power tapers from 1st December onwards by simplifying the procedure to have power connection by paying an amount of Rs 125/- per metre.
Action : S.E TRANSCO
6. To issue credit cards to handloom weavers as early as possible . **Action :: A.D H & T**
7. To see that all the HWOs to give importance to the education part of the hostel boarders. Simply providing provisions for food preparation is not their job chart integrated development and welfare of the boarders should be taken care off.
Action :: DD (SW), DBCWO & DTWO.
8. All Special Officers to send the record of action points regarding their visit to the villages.
Action :: All Special and District Officers
9. Transportation of sand from river beds should be avoided at village level/ /mandal officers , as the Village servant/ VROs/Tahsildars, PSs/MPDOS all are competent to cease those vehicles.
Action :: A.D Mines and DPO

10. In view of Bhagavan Sri Satya Sai baba's birthday on 23.11.09 there should be total control over excise in the surrounding village of Puttaprthy.

Action :: Excise Superintendent, ATP

11. To provide Education loans to students of the district this year also. **Action :: LDM**

12. One youth Associations in all villages to take up at least one model toilet to be constructed with an unit cot of Rs 3500/- **Action :: NYK Coordinator**

13. Writing up of Adangals and booking of crop with 100% accuracy to be completed, by the end of this month., **Action :: DRO & RDOS.**

Next is the present meeting number of issues of convergence are taken up

- The District Revenue Officer informed that 17 B.Cs 6 S.Cs and 2 Tribal surrendered from radical extreme affected places petitions for financial assistance are pending and requested to sanction at the earliest.

Action :: ED. S.C Corpotion, DTWO and ED B.C Corporation.

- Reimbursement of NSS amounts from different department to revenue department mainly irrigation departments . Hence the DRO is requested to settle this issue. **Action :: All concerned Departments.**

- Special Officers of some mandals noticed that there are no tents Medical kits and drinking water facilities at NREGP work sites and requested to provide them . Special Officer, N.P. Kunta received a complained from wage seekers that 20 % of the work done by them is not being accounted for making while bill payments.

Action :: PD DWMA.

- The Special Officer, Hindupur observed that the electricity transformer in ZPHS of Chowluru village of Hindupur Mandal is at very less height hence requested to provide at least fencing for safety of the students. . **Action:: SE TRANSCO**

- The DD Adult Education / Special Officer, Rapthadu noticed that one Post mortem report for the electric shock deceased case is pending at GGH, Anantapur. Requested to issue the report at the earliest. **::Action :: DM & HO**

- DD GWD/ Special Officer Bathalapalli informed that the Angan Wadi building in Obulapuram village is in dilapidated condition. One transformer is required in Yerrayapalli village **Action :: PD ICDS & SE TRANSCO**

- PD DWMA raised an previous issue of reimbursement of amount by J.D A.H immediately. As it is already persuaded many times . **Action :: JD AH**

- **PD DWMA** requested to complete all CLDP works at least by 10th December.

Action : : SE TRANSCO

- PD DWMA raised an issue of preparation of estimates and providing technical

advice by irrigation department to take up repairs to the breached check dams at Chamaluru village of Narpala Mandal as there is nearly 500 acres ayacut is there under that check dam . **Action :: SE .Irrigation**

- PD DRDA requested all special Officers to complete the verification of “ **Abhaya Hastham** “ applications by 20th of this month, as the scheme has to be launched on Dec.1st. **Action :: All Special Officers.**

- P.D Housing requested for power supply to the Kurugunta Housing colony as there are more than 600 completed houses as early as possible as drinking water facility also not been provided for want of power.

Action :: SE TRANSCO

- The Assistant Information Officer, NIC, Anantapur requested all the District officers to update the information pertaining to their department in the Anantapur web site. The format to be handed over to all officers in the next meeting **Action :: DIO & All District Officers.**

- The Joint Collector instructed to distribute fodder seed to raise fodder crops at least in 10 to 12 tanks in the District. **Action :: JD AH**

Before concluding the meeting it has been reviewed by the District collector the progress achieved under construction of model toilets in rural housing scheme with an unit cots of Rs 3500/-. The DEE Housing replied that the work has been taken up in 10 places and 1 completed and the cost analysis comes to Rs.8500/-. In this connection the District Collector instructed all the officers and even can be assigned to Revenue department to provide a model toilet with unit cost of Rs. 3500/- and that model can be spread to entire District as nearly 40% of un claimed bills are there for want of toilet block to Indiramma Housing colonies. It is a special challenge to all Special Officers , District Officers and to all to take interest with social mobilization on this issue and a low cost toilet model to be prepared.

Finally it has been concluded by the District Collector instructing all District officers to organize Army recruitment Rally and Sai Baba Birth day celebrations successfully.
