

Minutes of the Convergence meeting held on 27.12.2010

The District Collector reviewed Collector's Camp Office pending references and instructed to clear off at the earliest.

Other Instructions issued :

1. To call for explanation from the absentee officers to the 2 consecutive convergence meetings.
2. All Officers to do formal review in their offices periodically to improve performance of the department.
3. All the Special Officers and Super Special Officers to visit schools and hostels to improve educational standards.
4. The HWOs to identify the retired persons willing to teach students in hostels.
5. The Municipal commissioners in all municipal areas to place flexi charts to appeal the retired teachers and lectures to contribute voluntary services under the Programme "VIDYAKU CHEYUTHA " by giving contact phone numbers.
6. All Special Officers, Tahasildars and MPDOs to protect all tanks by trenches to avoid encroachments.
7. The J D Sericulture to publish draft handloom weavers list in the website, Tahasildar offices, RDO offices Municipal wards and in village panchayat offices, identified in the survey conducted by the department.
8. All District Officers concerned to invariably participate in the Divisional meetings with MPDOs being organized by the CEO, Zilla Parishad .
9. The J.D Animal Husbandry to impart trainings to sheep rearing persons on the following aspects, improving the weight of the sheep / goat by proper medical care, putting of one non local ram for cross breeding and to use weighing machines while selling them in the market yards.
10. To develop fodder and tank bed cultivation in the district with NREGS tie up and with inter departmental coordination by JD AH, Agriculture, PD DWMA and all special officers.

The District Collector reviewed in detail the pending and under process convergence meeting issues since beginning and instructed

- The CPO to sort out the under process and pending issues department wise and handover to all officers to update the status.

The District Collector reviewed the progress under Jawahar Bala Aarogya Beema programme claims settlement by the PO RVM

The District collector reviewed the progress under SGSY, S.C action plan assistance programmes with the ED SC Corporation and instructed to complete all units grounding at the earliest.

A review on analysis of student's quarterly marks was conducted and instructed the DEO to concentrate on getting high scoring by all students.

A review on the HLC / Minor irrigation sources water receipt position and urban drinking water was also conducted and instructed to inform progress every week.

Issues discussed :

- The PD DWMA informed about the previous issue of handing over of 8 year old tamarind trees raised in cldp blocks and in endowment lands which are in yielding stage and requested to handover these trees by local bodies at village level.

Action ::DPO

- The PD DWMA requested to furnish inspection reports immediately to DWMA in the prescribed formats on the works taken up under MPLADs programme as the consolidated reports are due to the Govt. Further it is also requested to furnish estimates for the newly proposed works under the programme.

Action SE RWS, PR and MPL. Commissioners.

- The PD DWMA requested all Special officers to ensure that the works under NREGS programme are started immediately in all villages as there are sufficient number of works already in shelves with the MPDOs. It is also requested to drill one bore well in Shaikshanipalli village of Uravakonda mandal to protect Dry land Horticulture crops raised.

Action :: SPI. Officers and SE RWS

- The RDO Dharmavaram requested to provide houses to the ST beneficiaries residing in the outskirts of Dharmavaram town. For this it has been instructed to take up the houses with RDT tie up.

- The RDO Dharmavaram informed that some TRASCO poles in the town are in falling stage and requested to rectify the defects.

Action :: SE TRANSCO

- The RDO Penukonda informed that there is no supply of drinking water in Mudigubba from the last four days and requested to rectify the problem.

Action:: SE SSW works.

- The Special Officer, N.P.Kunta, informed that there is delayed payment in the mandal due to diverting the employees for data entry work and requested to rectify the defect.

Action :: PD Housing.

- The PD APMIP raised an previous issue of energisation of bore well drilled for raising nursery at Moukthikapuram village of Muddinayanipalli. Kalyanadurg mandal.

Action ::SE TRANSCO.

- The EE IDC requested for issue of revised allotment of land to construct solar plant at Kutagulla near Kadiri .

Action :: RDO Penukonda.

- The Dist. Sports Development Officer informed that as per the latest Govt. Orders 3% of revenue to be given to Sports Development authority on sand transport and requested for adjustment of funds, whenever there are auctions. It is also requested to lay 40 metres CC Roads near Indoor stadium as present approach road is in bad condition.

Action :: DRO & ATP Mpl. Commissioner.
