

**Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 16.8.2010
at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur**

The District Collector in the inaugural address explained in brief the objective behind the conduct of Convergence Meeting to develop interdepartmental co-operation, rapport among the District Officers for speedy disposal of issues. Even after completion of one year the District Officers are very passive in discussing the issues relating to line departments, hence requested all the officers to be active in discussing the issues and allow the District Collector to be a calm observer rather than main spokesman.

Other instructions issued by the District Collector during the meeting are:

1. The E.D S.C. Corn to submit progress every week under the issue of TRANSCO feasibility certificates to S.C Corn., beneficiaries assistance programme.
2. The SE TRANCO to speed up to issue the feasibility certificates. At present only 3 to 5 certificates are being issued in a week, as the executive officers are spread in the entire District, total certificates be completed at the earliest.
3. The SE RWS to do smart work in total sanitation programme. The information collected in survey to be linked up to Housing scheme to speedy completion of the target of 100% coverage of sanitation in the selected 100 villages. In this connection it has been instructed to tie up any local NRI funds mobilization to fill any gap in financial aspects, as it is observed that there are many NGOs / NRIs coming forward to donate funds for development. It is instructed to all Special Officers to find NRIs e-mail ids of that village, to approach for funding to take up ISL schemes.
4. To organise trainings to masons at Mandal level in public participatory approach by the PD Housing to create awareness in constructing low cost model toilets and to see that 100% households to have functional ISLs. For this the PDs of DRDA and DWMA were also instructed to take personal interest in tying up this programme with NGOs and SHGs network also. The CIF of SHGs may be lend for construction of ISLs. The Revenue Divisional Officers were instructed to collect village wise number of masons available with their official channels.
5. The District Medical and Health Officer and the PD Women and Child welfare to create awareness among public through IEC campaign. For this meetings at District Level / Mandal level and village level to be conducted with suitable participants and also to identify the resource persons who can give electrifying lectures on the importance of sanitation. It is also instructed that the medical and Health persons to compulsorily meeting all V.Os in the district within one month on this issue.
6. The Town level statutory meeting for bankers and SLFs to be convened without any

10. The Chief Planning Officer to be cautious enough in conducting Crop cutting experiments .
11. The District Sports development Officer to tie up the Play grounds development programme with NREGS for leveling of land, and the guidelines to be communicated to Engineering staff.

A review on adoption of schools / Hostels by Special Officers under VIDYA KU CHEYOOTHA was taken up in the meeting and instructed as follows :

- To document any work done in developing the school / hostel by the special officers.
- To utilize the services of the retired teachers or NGO volunteers in developing the academic standards of the students.
- To provide English - telugu Dictionary in all classes from 6th standard onwards in all schools and hostels. For this the ED SC. Corporation to address the ADI foundation, an NGO who are interested in developing the academic standards of the district.
- For qualitative development in all aspects in the schools and Hostels the HWOs to ensure that all the instructions of Special Officers be followed.

Meeting on the eradication of manual scavenging and demolishing of Community Dry toilets has been convened by the District Collector with the ED S.C. corpn., line departments &NGOs, and following instruction were issued.

- To convene meeting to Gram Panchyat sarpanches, Eo RDs and Panchayat Secretaries where Dry toilets are existing to eradicate manual scavenging.
- To release pre metric scholarship to the children of unclean occupations immediately.
- To display the pending list of works relating to issue in all Tahasildars offices.

ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING

- The PO RVM raised an issue of providing power connection to schools. All the requirement has classified in to 2 stages one with poles requirement and the other to Meter deposit payment. In this connection requested the SE TRANSCO to provide power supply to immediately to the schools which paid the Meter deposit amount and the Estimates for erecting of poles requirement immediately.
- Action :: SE TRANSCO

- The PD Women & Child welfare requested to provide Govt land to construct Own Building to the Children Home at Hindupur. For this it has been instructed to submit proposals in the prescribed format.
Action:: RDO PKD & PD W & C Wel.
- The DD Social Welfare requested not to cut power supply to hostels for the reason of non payment of monthly bills. All dues will be paid immediately after receipt of budget and hence requested the SE Transco to consider the issue. Action :: SE TRANSCO
- The DD Social Welfare requested to alienate land to construct College Boys Hostel near ITI Anantapur. For this the District Collector instructed all Officers to send alienation proposals only with sufficient balances availability to take up construction work immediately. The delay in construction works are causing discrepancies to District Administration.
- The District B.C. welfare Officer requested to shift the Electric pole near Jyothi Rao Phoolle statue at Sangameswara circle of the town to avoid damages frequently causing to the statue. Action :: SE TRANSCO
- The CEO Zilla Parishad requested to tie up NREGS programme to all the repair work done to Gram Panchat buildings, Village Chavidies and Angan wadi buildings in villages. Action :: PD DWMA.
- The PD Housing requested to furnish the estimates by TRANSCO department for the newly energizing housing colonies. And also requested to furnish the utilization certificates for the earlier releases made by the Housing department with in a week. Action :: SEs of TRANSCO, RWS, and PR.
- The LDM requested the GM Industries to send the application under self employment programmes be sent to the controlling banks under copy intimation to the LDM for persuasions. Action:: GM Industries

Concluding the meeting, Dist. Collector instructed the Revenue Divisional Officers to see that all the "A" Category petitions received in PRAJAVAANI programme relating to revenue department be redressed at the earliest to build confidence among revenue staff as well as to cut down the scope for negative publicity.
