

Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 3.5.2010 at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur,

The District Collector reviewed the postal department issues in implementation of NREGS programme. It is instructed to ensure the presence of Branch Postmaster to the Mandal level convergence meetings, and also to take the Postal authorities to the NREGS work sites to speed up the disbursement and also to reduce the malpractices noticed.

Action:- Postal Superintendents, Special Officers and PD DWMA

While reviewing the land acquisition cases regarding settlement for the Rayadurg and Chitradurg Railway line lying work, A.D., Survey and Land Records is instructed to utilize the maximum capacity of their staff and machines to complete the entire work within 5 days to settle all claims.

Action:- A D Survey & Land Records

The District Collector instructed the SE RWS to prepare consolidated status on the drinking water issues raised in the Prajapatham visits to identify critical gaps for speedy redressal. It is also instructed to take up new bore drilling (including the hand pump set) only after obtaining the feasibility certificate from the G.W.Department and as per the local demand.

Action:- SE RWS

Review on the issues of meeting held on 27.4.2010 was taken up and following instructions were issued.

- ❖ To commence the Disabled pensioners verification programme as early as possible.

Action:- DM & HO., PD., DRDA and J.C.

- ❖ To take up social audit at Habitation level and also to maintain inspection register on the findings and also performance of the deputies.
- ❖ On 1st Saturday of every month Social Audit shall be inspected for at least 2 or 3 habitations along with the MPDO, Tahasildar, APO and Technical Officer to redress any issue there itself.

Action:- Special Officers

The Project Director DWMA explained in brief the importance of the Social Audit being conducted in the District. Recently, a State level team of Officers visited and studied the method of Social audit being conducted in the district. They opined that the same method is to be implemented in the entire state. The team studied the guidelines being followed in monthly social audits, the Convergence meetings, anantapur website information and also field level interactions with the NREGS wage earners. As this administrative mechanism is catching the attention of the entire state, Responsibility of all District Officers has increased in fruitful implementation of the programme.

It is also informed that from 1st May onwards 20% of summer allowance is also being paid to the wage earners which has to be highlighted during the visit to villages by the Special Officers.

The District collector informed that this system is evolved to cut down any irregularities in programme implementation and also to improve the efficiency in serving the poor wage seekers. It is also requested all officers to contribute their innovative ideas to improve the scheme.

The Project Director DRDA informed that as an incentive to the NREGS wage seekers, the District Administration is decided to provide screw bars free of cost to the SC/ST wage earners who completed 100 / 30 days of attendance respectively, for which, the orders were already placed with TATA Iron . For this it has been instructed to check the attendance with musters as preventive step to avoid complications.

A review on the Single Window Act with the line departments like Pollution control, SE TRANSCO, Inspector of Factories, DPO, Mpl. Commissioners, Dy. Commissioner of Commercial Taxes was held and instructed to complete all formalities by next meeting to ground all the units.

It is also instructed to conduct the 20 Point Programme meeting on every 1st Convergence meeting to save time and for the month of May, 2010 20 Point Programme meeting will be held at 5 PM on 10.05.2010 along with Convergence meeting. It is also instructed to invite the Convener, AP Social Welfare Residential Colleges, to the Monday convergence meetings in view of the ensuing next academic year .

ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING

- The P.O Rajiv Vidya Mission informed that the BPM is delaying in disbursement of wages in NREGS for the reason of shortage of Staff and requested to solve the problem.

Action:- PD DWMA & Postal Supdts.

- The P D Housing informed that nearly more than 160000 accounts are yet to be opened in post offices for Housing beneficiaries and requested to cooperate.

Action:- Postal Supdts.

- The DEO (FAC) requested the RDOs to alienate land for the Model Schools in all proposed 61 places to commence the construction work.

Action:- RDOs

- The SE TRANSCO informed that all 16 places where land alienation or transfer is required to construct the Sub Stations are ready with the department and will be handed over to the concerned Tahasildars in the Divl meetings scheduled on 4th & 5th and requested to speed up the sanctions.

- The District Revenue Officer informed that in Chennethapalli and Kanaganapalli mandals the social audits are being attended by only the Field Assistant. It is also noticed that some malpractices are also noticed. They should be rectified from postal department side.

- The District collector requested to provide local bus services to ISCON Temple near Somaladoddi Village to facilitate the visitors.

Action:- RM APSRTC

- The LDM requested to fix sign boards in the National Highway on the famous tourist place LEPAKSHI for attracting tourists crossing across the place.

Action:- DPRO and R&B and Tourism Dept.

- The District Collector instructed to combine all three meetings relating to Women welfare Department at a time.

Action:- PD Women & Child welfare.

- The Joint Collector raised the issue of procurement of Ground nut seed to meet the demand of the farmers in the District. The D.D.s of Mark Fed. and oil seed Fed are requested to keep sufficient stocks in the district by completing all arrangements for seed distribution programme.

Action:- DD MARKFED/Oil Seed

- The Joint Collector requested the District Officers to make preparations to organize Assets Distribution programme on the Concluding ceremony of Prajapatham (Rededication Day) on 15.05.2010.

Action:- PD IKP (U) & (R) and & others

- The DM AP SEEDS requested to provide 0.10 acres of land to take up construction of Go down near Anantapur. **Action:- RDO, ATP**

- The District Panchayat Officer raised the previous issue of Sanction of I S l toilets pending with the SE RWS., to be completed immediately.

Action:- SE RWS

- The DIO informed that some departments have to still send information to update in the website and requested to provide as early as possible.

Action:- Concerned Officers

- The District Collector instructed the AD H & Textiles and PD DRDA, (U), and Manager, Andhra bank, Dharmavaram to visit SIRISILLA to study the credit pattern being adopted there. LDM to coordinate.

Action:- AD H & T, PD DRDA, (U), and Manager, Andhra Bank

- The District Collector instructed to organize SHG meeting on 5th with Slum level federations and bankers to create awareness among the members on the high interest rates being charged by the Micro Finance institutions and also to getaway from their trap. It is the responsibility of Officers to do interest analysis and explain to the SHG members to flee from the trickery of the institutions .

Action:- PD IKP (U) & ATP MPL Commissioner.

- The PD MEPMA (IKP (U)) informed that Utilization certificates for an amount of Rs 95 lakhs is due from the Mpl Commissioners and requested to send them. The District Collector advised to address all Mpl Commissioners to attend the meeting on 5th with the UCs.

Action:- PD MEPMA & Mpl. Commissioners.

- The P D Housing requested the RDOs to instruct the Tahsildars to inspect the housing units under Integrated survey as the work relating to Ration cards and Pensions is completed. For this it has been instructed to the PD Housing to attend for the Divl. Meetings along with the detailed lists to be handed over to the Tahasildars. **Action:- RDOs & PD Housing.**

- The District Revenue Officer informed that in Kanaganapalli and Ramagiri mandals no passbooks / Account statements were issued to the housing beneficiaries. **Action:- PD Housing.**
- The Commissioner, Anantapur Municipal Corporation requested to depute a team of officers to delete the ineligible and Ghost pensioners in all 50 divisions in the Corporation. For this the District collector instructed to chalk out a clear programme with detailed guidelines, pinpointed Action plan and also prepare uniform format to get feedback information by drawing the Deputy Tahasildars, other departmental officers and Civil Supplies Department persons to function in a uniform procedure with 100% accountability.
Action:- Joint Collector, PD DRDA and Commissioner, Anantapur Municipal Corporation
- The District Collector instructed to get the entire list of Tractor Drivers verified whether they are having Driving license with the involvement of Village Revenue Officers immediately. **Action:- RDOs.**
- The District Collector instructed all the Special Officers to see that 100% of wage seekers and all village servants to be covered in insurance scheme by paying Rs 15/- P A.
- It is also instructed to clear off all the bills due to the organizing departments involved in the visit of H'ble Chief Minister to the District .
- The District Revenue Officer raised two court cases pending in the District, one relating to Sericulture Department and the other with Dist. Sports Authority and requested to have separate meeting with the District Collector to discuss on the issues.
Action:- JD Sericulture & Dist Sports Officer.
- The Joint Collector raised the previous issue of laying new Road by PR department with NABARD funds and maintaining the existing Road to the FCI go downs near Kandukuru Village where the villagers are agitation to stop the traffic. It is requested to prepare estimates for the works.
Action:- SE PR.

A brief review on the pending 122 issues of " PRAJAAVAANI " A Category petitions, department wise was made and instructed to reduce them as many as possible.

Finally, the District Collector instructed all the District Officers, particularly whose priority themes were there in Prajaptham programme to consolidate their departmental issues day wise and place in the Monday convergence meetings for review.
