

**Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 9.8.2010
at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur**

Before commencement of the meeting the Project Director DWMA gave a power point presentation on the implementation of MGNREGS programme during last year (with an financial out lay of Rs 83.40 crores) with photographic slides. The areas covered the programmes like SC / ST farmers land development, ground water recharge structures taken up in the districts keeping in view of the District geographical conditions were explained in the presentation. The tools like monthly Social Audit being implemented in the district to monitor the porgramme and transparency in administration were also highlighted in the presentation. The PD DWMA requested all the District Officers and Special Officers present in the meeting to give any suggestion in improving the performance of the programme.

The Joint Collector congratulated all the Officers of the District to put efforts beyond the expectations relating to the arrangements of the 500th coronation closing celebrations of Sri Krishnadevaraya at Penukonda.

The District Collector reviewed with the LDM and controlling officers of banks regarding the weekly and cumulative progress achieved in lending crop loans to farmers. In this connection, it has been instructed :

- to complete the original target of Rs . 1200 crores by August 15th and the remaining extra target of Rs. 400 crores by the end of this month.
- Not to deny lending to the assigned lands . In the case of Canara Bank C.K . Palli. Canara Bank controlling officer shall look in to the matter personally and see that no such cases arise in future.
- As the ING VYSYA BANK has completed only 40% of the target it has been instructed to catch up the particular branches and to motivate them to achieve the target.
- To encourage the students by providing the Education Loans

Other instructions issued by the District Collector during the meeting are:

1. The Revenue Officials to keep reserve lands in all villages by accessing the requirement of other departments in future.
2. The DEO to collect information from MEOs on the number of participants from each school for the Celebrations at Penukonda.
3. S E PR to complete the formation of Road work at Jagan Mohan Gutta of Penukonda immediately.
4. To organise exhibition stalls on the day of August 15th at police Parade Grounds as was done at Penukonda .
5. All District Officers to document and send their departmental success stories in telugu in 1 or 2 pages relating to 500th coronation Closing celebrations along with 2 or 3 photographs to Sri Vidya sankar, A.D Horticulture - I immediately to publish souvenir .

The District Collector appreciated all the Officers name by name with brief description of their performance in organizing the closing celebrations at Penukonda, and attributed the success to adopting the techniques of decentralization, public participation and inclusive approach adopted by the District administration . A brief retrospective interaction session also took place in the meeting.

ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING

- The SE RWS raised the previous issue of compensatory land alienation. In this connection it has been instructed to the Joint collector to settle the issue with in 10 days with forest Department Officials conciliation.
Action : JC, RDOS and DFO(T)
- The District Revenue Officer raised an issue of expenditure met by revenue department relating to supply of Drinking water, and requested for immediate reimbursement. Action :: SE RWS & SE PH
- The Tahasildar, D.Hirehal raised the issue that the TRANSCO officials are requesting for change of site to construct sub-station at Obulapuram . As the issue relates to land alienation and relinquishment, the RDO Dharmavarm and the SE TRANSCO were instructed to visit the site for sorting out. Action:: RDO Dharmavarm and SE TRANSCO.
- The EE Social welfare requested for alienation of 1.00 acre of land to start the construction work of sanctioned Social welfare Girls Hostel at Madakasira. Action :: RDO Penukonda
- The PD Women welfare requested to speed up all the alienation proposals submitted by the department for constriction of Anganwadi buildings . In this connection, local departmental officials of Women welfare were instructed to approach the concerned RDOs / Tahiasildars for redressal.
Action ::PD Women& Child wel. & RDOs

Concluding the meeting, Dist. Collector instructed all Officers to follow all the instructions issued by the District Administration and implement all the points raised in the meeting with serious commitment.
