

At the outset Handlooms and Textiles Department's annual review, and also the action plan for the next year has been approved by the Dist. Collector.

Integrated Co-operative Development Project and its progress has been explained by General Manager of the District Cooperative bank. It is also informed by the manager that except in Sheep farming societies in all other societies the recovery is good. Some Departments like Horticulture and Agriculture societies also need to utilize the benefits of the project's credit policies. It is also informed that the consumer society formed in the district by the students of SSBN College is running in good manner in the entire state.

The Project Director, DRDA explained that as per the G.O Nos 31 and 371 the District level monitoring committee has to work under the Chairmanship of the Dist. Collector to assess the disability level of the disabled pensioners in the District with the help of Software package prescribed. In this regard the Dist. Collector instructed the PD DRDA and Dist Medical and Health Officer to work out the prerequisites based on the number of disabled to be examined and the availability of Doctors in the respective fields in the District, and then to meet the Dist. Collector on tomorrow at 7.00PM in Camp Office. The entire exercise is to reduce the number of ineligible beneficiaries and to see that the total number of disabled pensions not to exceed 1.5% of the population. This screening should also be done in Social audit mechanism as discussed in earlier Convergence meetings.

The Project Director, DWMA reviewed the progress under on going works sanctioned under MPLADS, and requested all the executive agencies to submit proposals for release of 2nd installment funds immediately. It is also requested to finalize the works which needed to be dropped out.

The quarterly meeting of District level monitoring committee on elimination of Manual Scavenging, has been taken up the E.D S.C Corn. Ltd., It has been informed by the E.D that only 157 Community toilets are yet to be demolished in the District. When the District Collector asked for the Panchayat wise details, the Dist. Panchayat Officer informed that the Community Dry toilets are existing only in 28 panchayats only, and all the toilets will be demolished by the end of this month. For this the District collector instructed to work out the various substitutes like providing ISL / Sulabh complex or any other method as an alternative to the users. The representative of Safai Karmachary Andholan requested to provide the total details of the demolished Dry latrines, as even after the Judgment of the Supreme Court there is slackness in the work and requested the District Administration to eliminate the system at the earliest. While discussing on the issue the following instructions were issued by the District Collector:

1. To demolish the total Community Dry toilets with in time frame and to provide substitute for that. Action ::DPO, SE RWS CEOZP & ED SC.Corn.
2. To furnish the total list of Safai Karmahcaries in the District to the PD IKPs, Mpl. Commissioners to provide alternative livelihood to them. Also to provide Agricultural lands to them where ever possible to cover in the land distribution programme.

Action :: ED SC.Corn. & RDOs

3. To prepare the entire household profile of these Safai Karmacharies to cover in all feasible Govt schemes . Action :: ED SC Corn.
4. To provide Pre-matric scholarships if possible to the children of Safai karmacharies and to give every week progress on issue of scholarships.

The District Collector reviewed the progress achieved under drinking water projects in the 4 scheduled places for the H'ble C.Ms inauguration. It is also reviewed by the District Collector on the issues discussed in the Zilla Parishad General Body meetings and instructed as follows:

- To get the eligible beneficiary lists available in all PHCs ,. For sanction of Disabled pensions. Action ::PD D R DA
- To sanction Widow pensions instructed the Tahasildars to consider the genuinity of the cases by local enquiry also. Action :: RDOs.
- To verify the age of the beneficiaries with the Key Registers / Voter list available with the local Tahasildars.
- To re verify all the paths to the fields of Riots, as many objections are noticed in many situations and also the Easement Rights to the public be popularized.
- To furnish the total beneficiaries list by all the concerned offices to the public representatives to avoid complications.
- To intensify the verification of musters in all G.Ps. And also to readout the payments details in all GPs as wells as in all habitations by any representative of the Special Officer/ MPDO / Tahasildar.
- To see that the entire information on NREGP and Hosuing to reach up to habitation level.
- To see that the in addition to the monthly social audits, the details of payments made every week be available in all habitations.
- To take action on all the substandard muster verification officers.
- To give notes to the respective Departments on any issues noticed by the Special Officers in their visits to villages. The notes of the Special Officers to be considered as the note of the District Collector, as all the Special Officers are the representatives to the Dist. Collector at Mandal Level.
- To standardize the procedure of weekly inspection reports of the Special Officers relating to NREGS and housing. To put on paper on all the defaulting officers in furnishing the reports.
- To give weekly progress on the disbursement made to the NREGS wage seekers worked for PR Road works. And also to speed up the disbursement process in the works.
- All Special Officers to address the concerned postal Superintendent on any of the malpractices noticed in the Department .

The Dist Collector instructed the DD Ground water to prepare and submit the Sub-surface dice in Penna River

The General manager, AP Dairy Development Corporation explained the present scenario of Dairy in the District along with the success stories with the micro analysis of cost implications and the benefits of dairy activity to the district with power point presentation . The action plan of 2010-11 proposed to develop the number of cattle, milk procurement, no. of centres, and marketing of dairy products also explained

in detailed. The District Collector instructed DWMA, DRDA, Animal Husbandry, Agriculture, and APDDF to work in co-ordination to achieve the fixed targets .

Regarding the improvement in implementation of NREGS from the last 4 years i.e. from 2006 to 2010 in the District, based on the parameters like, average number of man days, work provided more than 100 days, expenditure and the percentage of improvement has been explained by the PD DWMA with Power Point pictorial presentation. The PD DWMA expressed thankfulness to the District Collector for sparing a lot of time to review the NREGS scheme with all the Special officers, and congratulated and all the District / Special Officers for their efforts to improve the performance of the scheme and also requested to extent similar cooperation in future to develop the living conditions of the rural public in the Districts like Anantapur. The District Collector instructed the DIO to place these two departments performance, and the details of the Beneficiaries identified to distribute land along with the programme schedule to place in the anantapur web site.

The District collector instructed all Officers to organize pre-Prajapatham meetings in all villages. And also to send the finalized village schedules by all mandals by 15th of this month to the Chief Planning Officer.

It is also instructed to send the notes by all the concerned officers by tomorrow 11.00 Am for consolidation of notes for the perusal of the District Collector in view of the H'ble Chief Minister video conference scheduled on 16th of this month.

A brief review on the arrangement made to the BHOO PAMPINEE Programme scheduled on 14th of this month was taken up by the Dist. Collector. The Rev. Divl Officer informed that for Anantapur Division the venue of the programme is Krishna Kalamandair at 3.00PM on 14.4.2010 and invited all officers to participate in the programme.

AFTER WHICH OTHER CONVERGENCE ISSUES DISCUSSED IN THE MEETING WERE :

- ❖ The Joint Collector requested the PD DWMA to alter the software available to issue NREGS Job card, as it is noticed in Uravakonda that there are some discrepancies in the beneficiary details furnished in the Household supply card and the Job card . **Action :: PD DWMA.**
- ❖ The District Revenue Officer raised an issue that in Garladinne Mandal, Penakachrla village the II Phase Transformer still to be erected. **Action :: SE TRANSO**
- ❖ The PD DWMA informed that the traditional water bodies can also be developed / maintained under NREGS . **Action :: Spl Officers**
- ❖ The Joint Collector requested the concerned officers to link economic packages to the beneficiaries of land distribution programme. **Action :: AD Hort., PD APMIP, DDGWD**
- ❖ The District Collector instructed to complete all meeting with bankers on the land records awareness by the end of April. **Action :: LDM**
- ❖ The Dist. Tribal Welfare Officer raised an issue that utilization certificates and work completion reports are due from the EE Social Welfare for the funds

released under SANKSHEMA BAATA PROGRAMME.

ACTION :: EE Social Welfare.

- ❖ The District Collector introduced, Sri Subba Reddy the new DFO to the District to all the Officers, and requested to inspect the lands proposed for compulsory afforestation programme.

Action :: DFO

- ❖ The Principal Govt. ITI Uravakonda raised an issue that the alienated land for construction of Govt college building is not feasible to construct and hence requested to alternative land for the ITI. And also to connect the 3 pace current to the building. The Dist Collector instructed to do joint inspection by the RDO and Principal Govt ITI for suitable land on 15th of his month. The deposit to be paid to change the Electric capacity to be made by the PD DRDA on monthly reimbursable method by the Principal ITI.

Action :: RDO, Principal GOVT ITI, PDDRDA, SE TRANSCO.

- ❖ The Joint Collector informed that for conversion of CPW scheme works at Uravakonda from the 11 KV to 33 KV the estimates are yet to be received from TRANSCO authorities.

Action :: SE TRANSCO.

- ❖ The CEO Zilla Parishad requested all officers to present for the ZP Standing Committee and other statutory meetings invariably to avoid unnecessary complications in conduct of statutory meetings.

Action :: All Officers.

- ❖ The Joint collector informed that Paddy procurement centres are being organized in the District in 8 centres, like Kanekal, Rayadurg, Guntakal, Garladinne, etc., if any new centres requirement may be brought to the notice of the Revenue Official to open.

Action :: All Spl. Officers.

Finally the District Collector in the concluding remarks, instructed all the District Officers to buildup / strengthen the gross root level net work in administration to get information in the event of natural calamities or unto wards incidents and also to be available in any of the District level important meetings whenever scheduled.
