

Minutes of the Convergence Meeting held by District Collector, Anantapur on 11.01.2010
at DWMA Conference Hall, Anantapur

The District Collector, Anantapur at the outset reviewed daily status of NREGS progress. A special personality development concepts through Power Point Presentation has been initiated by the District Collector as a New Year message to all District Officers.

It has been instructed to put in special efforts to bear the cost of surgery of such children who are born deaf and dumb either under Arogyasree or any rural development programmes.

Detailed discussion was taken up on enhancing the MILK procurement capacity and Dairy Development activity in the district as the Dairy activity is the only next best alternative to Agri in the district.

In this connection the following instructions were issued to the DD Dairy, PD DRDA, and JD A.H.

- To regularize and re-organize the milk routes.
- To aim to reach optimum utilization of the Milk Collection centers.
- To have a complaint box in all centers.
- Some of the Sr Dist. Officers to visit the centres where procurement capacity is less than 25000 Lts. like, Garladinne, Ramagiri, Dharmavaram, NP Kunta etc., and gradually motivate them to increase intake.
- Overall monitoring is to be done by the DD. Dairy and AD. (A.H)

After that the District Collector instructed all the Officers as follows:

1. Stick on to Optimum utilization of available Men & Material in the New Year.

2. Procurement of Red Gram where it is being produced in the village itself by the SHG members to curb the middle men in the market and also to provide food security. A meeting to be held with all Dal Mill owners and the Zilla Samakhya to see that village level production to be used in that village only by the PD DRDA.

3. All District Officers may use wireless Sets to hold meeting with the subordinates.

4. The DTWO to interact with the SE. RWS for rural sanitation issues and to put a special drive for removal of manual scavenging as per the Govt. orders and also to send the entire list of beneficiaries requesting for assistance under bank linkage to the NSKFC.,

5. For the ensuing Republic Day celebrations on 26-1-2010 D.E.O., has been instructed to **organize programmes with cultural look**, and all the Officers to send the Notes for the preparation of District Collector's Message by 12.1.10. and all important Officers to organise special effects on the Parade.

6. Instructed all to wear Handlooms on every Saturday.

7. The Notes given by the Collectors Camp Office and Important references pending with all the Officers also to be replied immediately.

8. To compulsorily provide Ragi and Gur in Girls Hostels to reduce the anemic condition of girl students in the district.

9. Any Grievance should not be neglected without knowing the content.

10. On Every 1st Saturday of the month Social Audit should be conducted, even though there are no NREGP works.

11. To achieve maximum number of model toilets in all villages by the end of this month.

12. The PD DRDA / IKP to put special drive to improve repayment capacity of the SHGs to build confidence among banks and also get next loans. A letter may also be addressed to all bank branches to hold meeting with all the members of the SHG before financing.

14. All Departmental heads to dispose off any vehicles in condemn stage as per the Guidelines of the Govt.

After that convergence meeting other issues were taken up by DPO

- 1. The DTWO raised an issue that as per the report of the DPO only 46 Community toilets are in use in the District for Demolition. But as per the survey of their filed staff there are 134 number existing. For this issue it has been instructed by the District Collector to categorise the toilets in two categories as lack of place to construction ISIs and lack of money to take up the ISI and take action accordingly. **Action : DTWO, DPO, CEO Z.P**
- 2. The Joint Director of Agrl. Informed that on 17th at 11.00 AM at KSR Govt College, Anantapur Sankranti Puraskaraalu programme is being organized as per the instructions of the Govt. and requested all the line Depts of Agrl. Like Sericulture, A.H, Rural development officers to participate in the programme and on the same day at 3.00 PM at DWMA meeting hall a special meeting on Integrated Development of Govindapuram and Gagulavari palyam villages of Madakasira (M) is also there. Hence requested the PD DWMA, PD DRDA, CEO ZP, JD AH, JD Sericulture, AD Fisheries, Horticulture Po SSA. DM & HO SE MI, SE PR, SE RWS, DD SW, DBCWO, DTWO, DYWOs to be attend the meeting with the village profiles of those two villages to have detailed deliberations. **Action :: PD DWMA, PD DRDA, CEO ZP, JD AH, JD Sericulture, AD Fisheries, Horticulture Po SSA. DM & HO SE MI, SE PR, SE RWS, DD SW, DBCWO, DTWO, DYWOs**
- 3. The District Revenue Officer briefly reviewed the Prajaavani A Category petitions status department wise and requested to redress them immediately. **Action : All the Dist. Officers.**
- 4. The Notes given by the Collectors Camp Office to be placed in the Dist. Web site immediately. **Action :: DIO, NIC,**
- 5. The Joint Collector asked for the pre valuation reports for settling the LA cases. **Action : AD HORTICULTURE**
- 6. The PO RVM requested all the Welfare Department Officers to send the Acquittances for the honorarium paid to the Vidya Volunteers appointed in all welfare Hostels to release budget for the next year. **Action :: DDSW, DTWO, DSBCWO, AD Disabled Welfare.**
- 7. The Chief Planning Officer informed that all the Officers were provided with a small pocket book to note the convergence meeting issues. Further it has been explained in detailed about the NON-Profit Institutions survey being conducted

in the entire State of Andhra Pradesh, and requested the concerned officers to instruct the lower level staff to provide accounts / records to the Filed staff of the Planning Department, for filling of Schedules relating to the Survey of NPIs and the copy of such letter may be sent to the Chief Planning Officer for necessary action. **Action :: PD DRDA, PD DWMA, DEO, DCO, AD, Disabled welfare, DYWO.**

- 8. The PD DWMA, explained in detail the present status and process of NREGS works in the district. So far 750 crores value of works sanctioned in all Mandals and 13000 new Working Mates were trained to assist the wage seekers in work sites, it has been requested to all Special Officers to take interest in execution of works. Now the Filed Assistants work become supervisory and their services can also be utilized at optimum level. All Special and Senior Officers to stream line the entire process and to see that entire funds released under NREGS - be sanctioned by the MPDOs and ensure that the work orders be in the hands of working mates. Further it has been explained that in all 15 Mega Water Shed areas like Atmakur, Guntakal, Kanaganapalli, Vajrakarur, Gooty, Settur, Kalyanadurg, Kanekal, Puttaparthi, Etc., all sectoral officers to interact with the NGOs assigned for preparation of Detailed project report for inclusion of their departmental issues coverage. It is also requested to complete energisation of all 14 CLDP works in the district and settle all the power accidental death cases by the SE Transco. **Action :: All Sectoral Officers, SE TRANSCO, MPDOs.**

The District Collector instructed all the Officers to maintain Dairy in this new year to have monthly self assessment and performance appraisal. The monthly self fixed targets and achievement, value addition in the work done at the end of month to be analyzed for better development and the same issue will be reviewed by the District Collector in the 20 Point programme meeting scheduled on every month 5th or in the special

Finally the District Collector in the concluding remarks once again wished all the Officers Happy New Year and Pongal, and to make the Republic Day celebrations grand success.
