

## Minutes of the convergence meeting held on 13/09/2011 in DWMA hall

- Dist collector reviewed the Collectorate's pending references with all the departments and informed all the District Officers that this item will be reviewed every week on the Action taken.
- With regard to functioning of Science clubs in various schools the collector has informed that awareness is to be created among school children by taking them to Viswesvaraiiah Museum, Bangalore, Sri Venkateswara Museum, Tirupathi. A programme is to be chalked out to take students with small contributions .

(Action: DEO and JVV to plan in this regard)

- Collector also insisted upon evolving a strategy to form a trained team consisting up of CRP from DRDA, ASHA worker from medical and Health, AWW from W&CW and NGO's at least 2 for each mandal with a time frame material for easy understanding on hygienic tools within 10 days with time tested models for quick awareness on personal hygiene. among school children and rural women. In case of girl students in Jr. colleges, RIO is instructed to chalk out a plan to conduct meetings with a Gynecologist.

( Action: PD,DRDA,DM&HO, JVV, PD,W&CW)

- Revenue Divisional Officers are instructed to create awareness among rural mass by Tom-tom in the villages. DM&HO is instructed to direct Medical Officers to prepare Disease Profiles about disease affected absenteeism in schools.
- Coming to the point of urban areas, Collector reviewed the role of newly appointed Environmental Engineers in creating awareness in waste collection community mobilization, segregation of waste, waste trampling, and preparation of Wormy Compost . In this regard, the Collector advised all the Environmental Engineers and Mpl commissioners to make a visit to Kadapa municipal corporation on solid waste management and wormy compost and to prepare plans for best use of funds allocated under this scheme and keeping in view of its future implications.

( Action: All Env.Engineers and mpl Commissioners)

- Keeping in view of the District , The Collector instructed DM&HO to chalk out a plan with the cooperation of AD drugs and Dr Geyanand ,JVV , PD.DRDA to make available GENERIC Medicine with a suitable nomenclature and to open medical shops with public Private partnership for viable functioning of new shops.

( Action: DM&HO, AD drugs and Dr Geyanand, JVV , PD, DRDA)

- Collector instructed PD.DRDA to finalise pension cases pending to all eligible physically challenged persons to almost 2000 cases citing 461 Amarapuram mandal. CEO ,ZP is instructed to give proposals to all eligible PHC cases in the district.

(Action: PD,DRDA and CEO, ZP)

- With inter departmental issues pending ,DM industry requested for sorting of 5 cases with SE Transco,3 with DPO 2 with Pollution Control Board.

- Collector instructed to hold statutory meetings periodically within the departments without any hindrance.

- SDC,HNSS requested to DD treasury, honour cheques issued by PAO for immediate payments as the amounts deposited are of compensation in nature and would be lapsed if not paid immediately. District BC welfare Officer also requested to honour scholar ship cheques to be cleared immediately by DD Treasuries & Accounts.

( Action: DD Treasuries & Accounts)

- District manager, NABARD has requested to get bills cleared as 700 crores funds are allocated for various departmental works. EE, GWIDC has requested for clearance of 130 lakhs for the completed school bldg works .like wise, SE PR has requested DM NABARD to clear bills pending for completed AWW building works.

- Forest conservator has requested for sanction of funds for maintenance of Bio Diesel plants in 237 Ha as huge funds are spent for development the area and it requires 60laks for maintenance. EE GWIDC instructed to take up and complete toilets in all school buildings.
- SE RWS and SE TRANSCO to sort out problems in Penukonda Arch erection as it is to be completed before November .CEO, ZP to coordinate in this regard.
- Principal, Govt Degree College is instructed to finalise the work regard to Model Degree college.
- PD DWMA has requested AD Survey & land records to identify the 119 ac under CLDP block in Singanahalli of Bommanahal mandal. SE TRANSCO is requested to sort out the problem of deposit of Rs 5000/by Hand bore beneficiaries (poor farmers) of Bollandaguddam, Govindawada and D. Honnur in Bommanahal mandal. JD, Agriculture and JD, AH are requested to develop block plantation in their farms. RDOs are also requested to give proposals to PD, DWMA for Block Plantation development and 3 year maintenance near Tank bed, Peripheral trenching etc.,
- Collector instructed all welfare departments for tomorrow's Monitoring & Evaluation Programme and instructed them to react immediate action whenever there is an atrocity on weaker sections citing Uravakonda case.
- Instructed DM&HO to send letters to all PHC medical Officers to get analysis reports on snake bite death cases.
- DFO informed that panther attack victims /death cases are paid immediate compensation and medical bills incase of injured persons, citing the incidents of Tanakal ,Kalyandrug and Singanamala.
- RDO, DMM has informed that they are sanctioning compensation in Apadbandhu cases immediately while Insurance departments are rejecting such cases.
- PO SSA requested SE TRANSCO to give immediate Electric Connections to all schools. Pending bills would be paid in case of disconnected meters. Collector instructed them to write letters to concerned AEEs and MEOs respectively.
- RDO ,DMM is requested to provide site to APD, DWMA office in DMM and Rayadrug.
- SE RWS is requested to sort out the problem of leakage of DW scheme in Singanamala village as Typhoid cases are being observed in the mandal.
- DM&HO requested RDO DMM to concentrate on sterilization cases as poor progress is observed in Ramagiri, Beluguppa and Kanaganapalli mandals.
